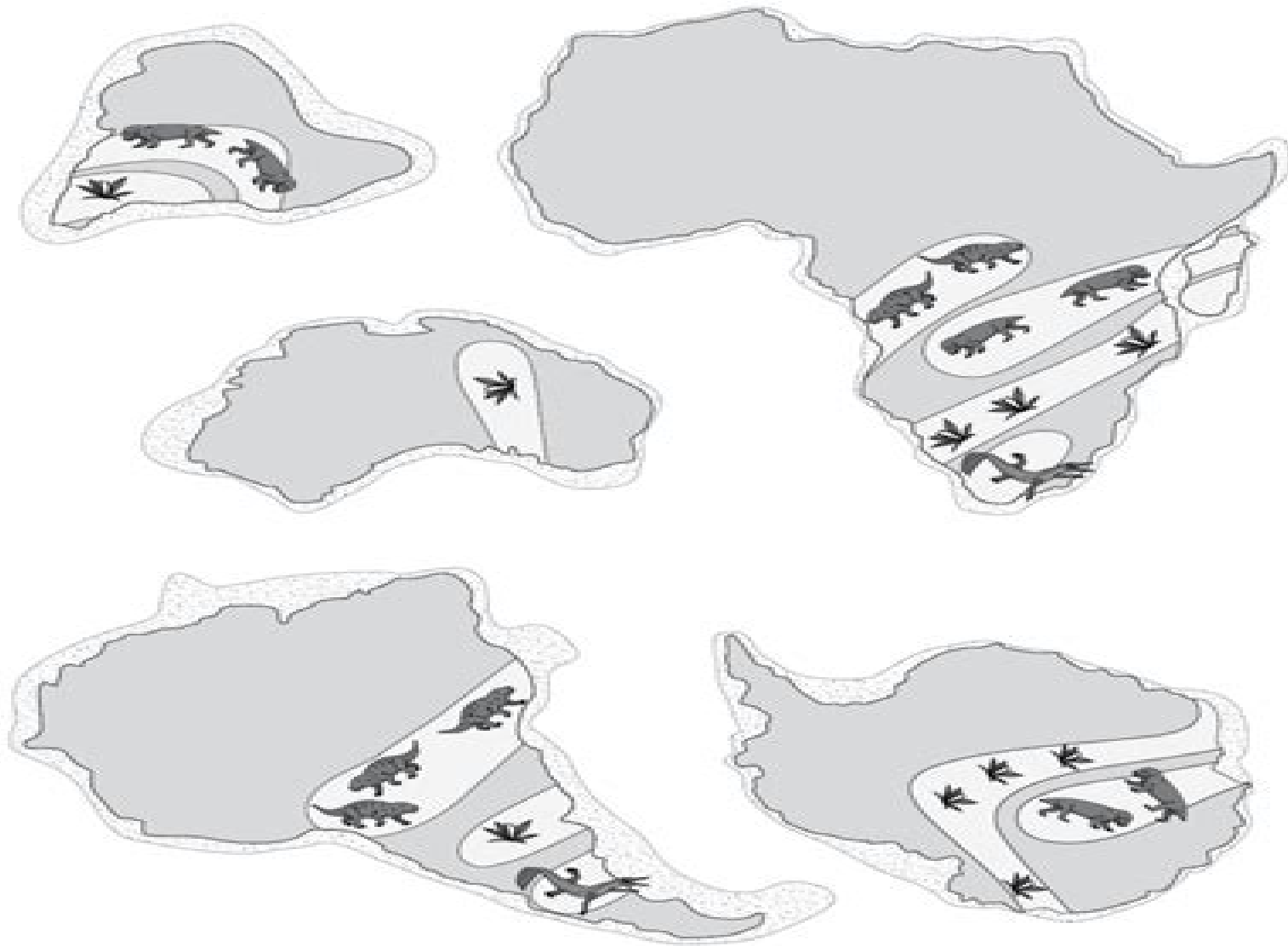

Preparing Dinosaurs Caitlin Donahue Wylie, 2021-08-31 An investigation of the work and workers in fossil preparation labs reveals the often unacknowledged creativity and problem solving on which scientists rely Those awe inspiring dinosaur skeletons on display in museums do not spring fully assembled from the earth Technicians known as preparators have painstakingly removed the fossils from rock repaired broken bones and reconstructed missing pieces to create them These specimens are foundational evidence for
