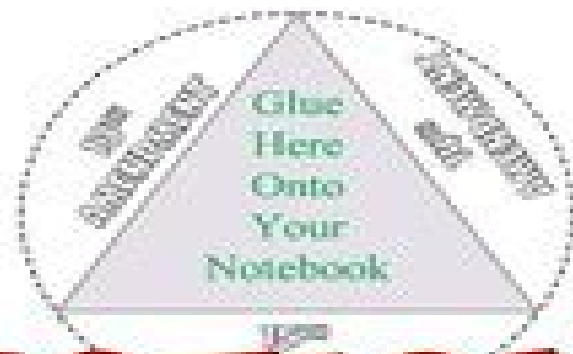

Much of the legislation that came after 1865 is credited to the work of the Radical Republicans, who favored abolition and did not hold compromise as ending slavery. Despite Congressional support, there were many Southerners who were not in favor of these amendments, and they worked to increase the tensions that had begun after the Civil War.

The 13th Amendment passed in Congress on January 31, 1865, a few months before President Lincoln was assassinated. It was not formally ratified until December 6 of that year. The 14th Amendment is considered as the one which formally ended slavery in the United States.
