- Describe the main character of this book using 4 adjectives. (example: kind, funny, creative).
- Summarize what you read today. What important events occurred?
- Pretend you get to interview a character. Which character would you interview and what two questions would you ask him or her?
- If you had to give this story a new title what would it be and why?

NONFICTION RESPONSES

- What are two interesting facts you have learned from your reading?
- What unfamiliar words have you come across? Use context clues or a dictionary to find the meaning.
- What do you think is the main idea of the text?
- What text structure did the author use to organize the text? (Chronological, Cause & Effect, Compare & Contrast, Description, Problem and Solution)
- Summarize what you read today in a few sentences.
- What is your opinion on the topic of the text? Explain why you feel the way you do.
- Identify a cause and effect relationship from the text and explain it.
- If you could interview the author what two questions would you ask him or her?
