Key Themes:

Love:

Key Characters and their traits:

Romeo Montague:

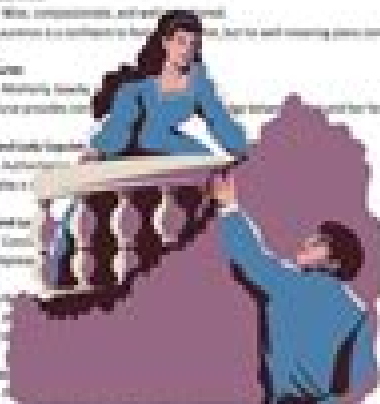
