

Conclusions

It is here that the research can both summarise his or her findings and suggest applications of those findings. Again, such applications should be realistic and no attempt should be made to extrapolate beyond the data. Arguably, it is impossible to generalise from qualitative data (because of the sampling methods, the ways of collecting data and the methods of analysis) — and most would say that it is not the point of doing qualitative research to generalise in this way. However, it is sometimes a temptation for the research to project his or her chance to reflect on his or her own practice and, as appropriate, be critical of the approach adopted here. While there can never be a standardised template for writing research reports, certain features *always* occur in any account.
