CHEM 101 General Chemistry-I

3 credits

Prerequisites: High school chemistry and college algebra, sufficient mathematics for the college algebra placement test, or equivalent passing scores on standardized chemistry placement exam, permission to seek admission to chemistry grade of 12 or higher.

General Education Area/Institution Requirement: Physical Science (20)

Summer 2020

Term Typically Offered: Fall, Spring

Introduces chemistry fundamentals on atomistic level, including bonding, molecular structure, chemical reactions, solutions, stoichiometry, acid-base chemistry, equilibrium theory, thermodynamics, electrochemistry, and chemical kinetics. Includes three hours laboratory where hands-on experiments are performed.

Notes: This course is equivalent to Engineering degree entry requirement CHEM 101 General Chemistry for Engineering.

CHEM 102 General Chemistry-II

3 credits

Prerequisites: CHEM 101 or other chemistry grade of 12 or higher.

General Education Area/Institution Requirement: Natural Science (20)

Summer 2020

Term Typically Offered: Fall, Spring

Continuation of the development of fundamental principles of chemistry and introduction of specialty knowledge including 1st, 2nd, 3rd law of thermodynamics, equilibrium, electrochemistry principles, including non-equilibrium systems, coordination chemistry, acid-base chemistry, organic chemistry, kinetics, laboratory and basic knowledge of toxicology and environmental pollution of chemicals.

CHEM 103 General Chemistry for Engineering

3 credits

Prerequisites: High school chemistry, math skills equivalent to level 100 for pre-engineering or the college chemistry placement exam.

Prerequisites: High school chemistry, math skills equivalent to level 100 for pre-engineering or the college chemistry placement exam, permission to seek admission to chemistry grade of 12 or higher or

Term Typically Offered: Fall, Spring, Summer

A one semester chemistry course for engineering students covering fundamental principles and concepts of chemistry relevant to engineering applications. Includes topics such as chemical structure, chemical bonding, equilibrium, solutions, kinetics, thermodynamics, electrochemistry, acid-base chemistry, coordination chemistry, and chemical kinetics. Includes three hours laboratory where hands-on experiments are performed.

Notes: Considerable of this course is required for Engineering degree.
