The Unique Characteristics of the Paleolithic Era
The Paleolithic Era, also known as the Old Stone Age, was a time when early humans relied on food unconsciously for survival. This period, lasting from about 2.5 million years ago to roughly 10,000 BCE, is considered some of the most important developments in human history.

One of the defining characteristics of the Paleolithic Era was the nomadic lifestyle. Early humans, known as hunter-gatherers, did not settle in one location but instead lived in temporary shelters and moved from place to place in search of food and shelter. This lifestyle was characterized by a constant search for resources and a deep understanding of the natural world.
