The American Poet Laureate Amy Paeth, 2023-05-16 The American Poet Laureate shows how the state has been the silent center of poetic production in the United States since World War II It is the first history of the national poetry office the U S poet laureate highlighting the careers of Elizabeth Bishop Robert Frost Gwendolyn Brooks Robert Pinsky Tracy K Smith Juan Felipe Herrera and Joy Harjo at the nation's Capitol It is also a history of how these state poets participated in national arts programming during the Cold War Drawing on previously unexplored archival materials at
