Quine's critics have questioned the possibility of such a descriptive project to account for epistemic normativity on the ground that a purely descriptive scientific approach cannot tell us how we should form beliefs. The argument of the critics is that the project to naturalize epistemology might simply describe how beliefs are formed without providing any guidance on whether those beliefs are justified or true. But among other insights, the author argues that Quine's *Naturalized Epistemology* can accommodate epistemic norms, suggesting that it can help us understand how to achieve our epistemic goals and potentially rectify misconceptions about epistemic
