

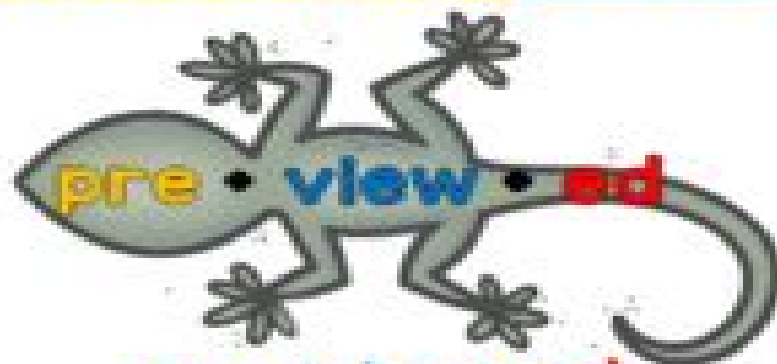
Prefix, Suffix, Base Word Classroom Poster

Prefix is the head

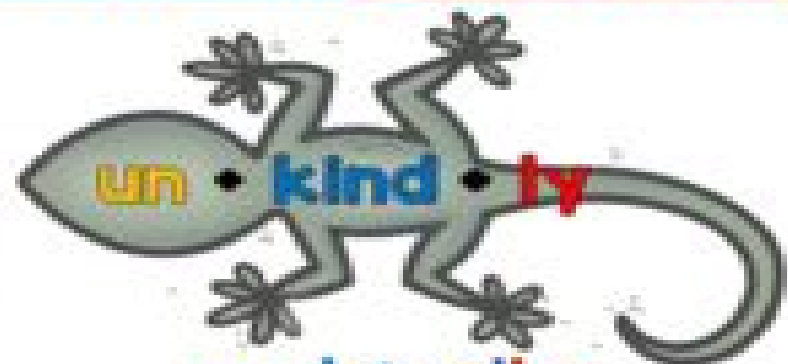
