world's highest mountain. It's a tale of high drama of larger than life characters: George Everest, Francis Younghusband, George Mallory, Lord Curzon, Edward Whymper and a few quiet heroes: Alexander Kellas, the 13th Dalai Lama, Charles Bell. A story that traverses the Alps, the Himalayas, Nepal and Tibet, the British Empire, especially British India and the Raj, the Anglo-Russian rivalry known as The Great Game, the disastrous First Afghan War and the phenomenal Survey of India.
