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The Social Citizen Betsy Sinclair, 2012-12-10 Human beings are social animals Yet despite vast amounts of research into political decision making very little attention has been devoted to its social dimensions In political science social relationships are generally thought of as mere sources of information rather than active influences on one's political decisions Drawing upon data from settings as diverse as South Los Angeles and Chicago's wealthy North Shore Betsy Sinclair shows that social networks do not merely inform citizen's behavior they can and do have the power to change it From the decision to donate money to a campaign or vote for a particular candidate to declaring oneself a Democrat or Republican basic political acts are surprisingly subject to social pressures When members of a social network express a particular political opinion or belief Sinclair shows others notice and conform particularly if their conformity is likely to be highly visible We are not just social animals but social citizens whose political choices are significantly shaped by peer influence The Social Citizen has important implications for our concept of democratic participation and will force political scientists to revise their notion of voters as socially isolated decision makers

Designing for Democracy Jennifer Forestal, 2022 How should we fix digital technologies to support democracy instead of undermining it In Designing for Democracy Jennifer Forestal argues that accurately evaluating the democratic potential of digital spaces means studying how the built environment a primary component of our modern public square structures our activity shapes our attitudes and supports the kinds of relationships and behaviors democracy requires While many scholars and practitioners are attentive to the role of design in shaping behavior they have yet to fully engage with the question of what structures are required to support democratic communities and how to build them Forestal closes this gap by providing a new theory of democratic space Drawing from a wide range of disciplines including architecture psychology and the history of political thought she argues that democratic spaces must be designed with three environmental characteristics boundaries durability and flexibility that taken together afford users the ability to engage in fundamental civic practices Through extended analyses of Facebook Twitter and Reddit Forestal shows precisely how well these digital platforms meet the criteria for democratic spaces or whether they do so at all The result is a more nuanced analysis of the democratic communities that form or fail to emerge in these spaces as well as more concrete suggestions for how to improve them In connecting the built environment digital technologies and democratic theory Designing for Democracy provides blueprints for democracy in a digital age

Gilbert,2009 Abstract **Serpents in the Sand** Courtney Brown,2025-10-01 For decades social scientists have worked with models that have sought to quantify and explain human behavior The common foundation for nearly all of these mathematical applications is the assumption of linear progression equilibrium and stability Serpents in the Sand not only argues that political life is fundamentally nonlinear but thoroughly analyzes specific instances of extreme nonlinearity in politics By so doing Courtney Brown offers a guide to the reader on how to apply nonlinearity including chaos theory to real world situations The author develops his argument by in depth analysis of four examples covering a broad spectrum of political life He considers first the relationship between individual rationality and the influence of a voter s political milieu He then turns to look at the dynamics behind the Johnson vs Goldwater landslide presidential election of 1964 The fall of the Weimar Republic and the rise of Nazi Germany provide a third case study followed by an analysis of the relationship between democratic electoral politics and the ecological environment Highly original in its finding Serpents in the Sand resembles no other work on politics It is the first study of nonlinearity in political behavior to base its argument on specific examples rather than on analogies to physical and ecological systems Substantively the book draws provocative conclusions from the test cases examining for instance the potential for disaster in the oscillatory relationship between the way U S presidents are elected and the management of the country s environment In the end Serpents in the Sand extends its argument to the philosophy of human existence showing that human behavior is as nonlinear as all other processes in the universe Courtney Brown is Associate Professor of Political Science Emory University

Real Democracy Frank M. Bryan,2010-03-15 Relying on an astounding collection of more than three decades of firsthand research Frank M Bryan examines one of the purest forms of American democracy the New England town meeting At these meetings usually held once a year all eligible citizens of the town may become legislators they meet in face to face assemblies debate the issues on the agenda and vote on them And although these meetings are natural laboratories for democracy very few scholars have systematically investigated them A nationally recognized expert on this topic Bryan has now done just that Studying 1 500 town meetings in his home state of Vermont he and his students recorded a staggering amount of data about them 238 603 acts of participation by 63 140 citizens in 210 different towns Drawing on this evidence as well as on evocative witness accounts from casual observers to no lesser a light than Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn Bryan paints a vivid picture of how real democracy works Among the many fascinating questions he explores why attendance varies sharply with town size how citizens resolve conflicts in open forums and how men and women behave differently in town meetings In the end Bryan interprets this brand of local government to find evidence for its considerable staying power as the most authentic and meaningful form of direct democracy Giving us a rare glimpse into how democracy works in the real world Bryan presents here an unorthodox and definitive book on this most cherished of American institutions

The Unbounded Community Kenneth A. Scherzer,1992-05-12 Stick ball stoop sitting pickle barrel colloquys The neighborhood occupies a warm place in our cultural memory a place that Kenneth A

Scherzer contends may have more to do with ideology and nostalgia than with historical accuracy In this remarkably detailed analysis of neighborhood life in New York City between 1830 and 1875 Scherzer gives the neighborhood its due as a complex richly textured social phenomenon and helps to clarify its role in the evolution of cities After a critical examination of recent historical renderings of neighborhood life Scherzer focuses on the ecological symbolic and social aspects of nineteenth century community life in New York City Employing a wide array of sources from census reports and church records to police blotters and brothel guides he documents the complex composition of neighborhoods that defy simple categorization by class or ethnicity From his account the New York City neighborhood emerges as a community in flux born out of the chaos of May Day the traditional moving day The fluid geography and heterogeneity of these neighborhoods kept most city residents from developing strong local attachments Scherzer shows how such weak spatial consciousness along with the fast pace of residential change diminished the community function of the neighborhood New Yorkers he suggests relied instead upon the unbounded community a collection of friends and social relations that extended throughout the city With pointed argument and weighty evidence The Unbounded Community replaces the neighborhood of nostalgia with a broader multifaceted conception of community life Depicting the neighborhood in its full scope and diversity the book will enhance future forays into urban history

Putting Inequality in Context Christopher Ellis, 2021-03-11 Rising income inequality is highlighted as one of the largest challenges facing the United States affecting civic participation and political representation Although the wealthy often can and do exert more political influence this is not always the case To fix political inequality it is important to understand exactly how class divisions manifest themselves in political outcomes and what factors serve to enhance or depress inequalities in political voice Christopher Ellis argues citizens and legislators views of class politics are driven by lived experience in particular communities While some experience is formally political on an informal basis citizens learn a great deal about their position in the broader socioeconomic spectrum and the social norms governing how class intersects with day to day life These factors are important for policymakers since most legislators do not represent the public at large but specific constituencies Focusing on U S congressional districts as the contextual unit of interest Ellis argues individuals political behavior cannot be separated from their environment and shows how income s role in political processes is affected by the contexts in which citizens and legislators interact Political inequality exists in the aggregate but it does not exist everywhere It is rather a function of specific arrangements that depress the political influence of the poor Identifying and understanding these factors is a crucial step in thinking about what reforms might be especially helpful in enhancing equality of political voice
