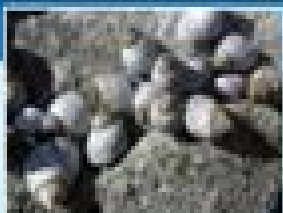


Blue Periwinkle

Thais haasbroekii

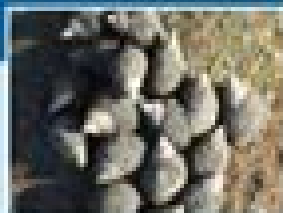
Often found clustering together at the highest tide level. These molluscs sit atop or below all the rocks. They are almost invisible with a pale blue-grey tint. This species can survive well above mean high tide level.



Parroted Clamshell

Placostrophia subulata

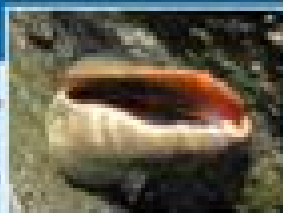
Commonly seen in large clusters under the rock shelves or edges of rock pools. As the common name suggests, the black or variegated shell surface has smooth, rounded, beak-like ridges.



Red-mouthed Shrimp

Stomatopoda subulata

Resembles a crane shell but this species has a slightly in-turned corner joint to seal up and a deep notch at the bottom. It lives mainly in colonies in shallow water amongst rocks. They live in the Manxwater River but to low of tides.



Cone Shells

Conus spp.

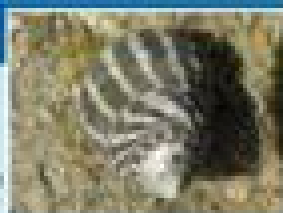
The cone shells pictured are commonly found local species. Cone shells, with power extending from between small white triangles, is also present on the coast. It shows precise dark bands by looking at all the rings.



Zebra Top Shell

Hydrobia ulvae

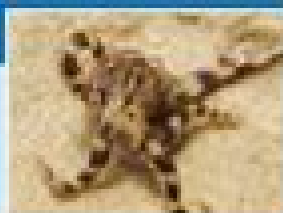
These small 30mm molluscs are attractively patterned with black and white horizontal bands of varying width. They are one of the most common species found feeding on rock shelves when the tide is receding.



Blue-ringed Octopus

Teuthididae

This small 30mm octopus is very dangerous. Its natural grey-brown colour helps it blend into the rocks and sandy beds of the rock pools. When disturbed its bands turn fluorescent blue.



Nerita

Nerita spp.

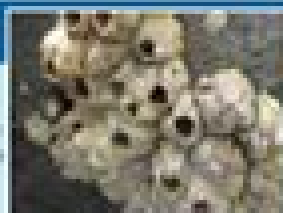
Nerites have a patterned shell as they feed on the rock edges or rocks. It feeds and moves mainly at night. These species can grow to around 30mm and have a range of different shell colours and patterns.



Rose Barnacle

Semibalanus rostratus

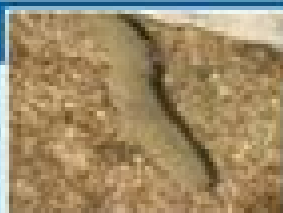
A white mollusc often found with pink. They are like small plates and the species grow to about 20mm wide and 10mm high. The empty shells have been eaten by periwinkle species such as *Hydrobia ulvae*.



Black Sea Cucumber

Parastichia ulvae

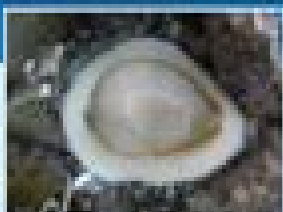
This species can grow to 300mm long or larger. The colour is black but is often seen covered with sand. It moves by rearing up then stretching out its body. It emits a black red dye when touched.



Gold-ring Cowrie

Cyprina annular

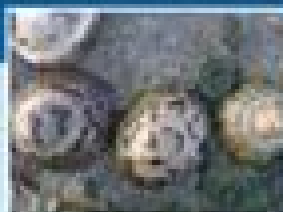
Occasionally found in the intertidal zone in rock pools and crevices. This 30mm mollusc has a distinctive yellow or orange ring on the top and a creamy base and sides. It can be distinguished from the similar Money Cowrie by the angle shape.



Limpets

Crepidula fornicata

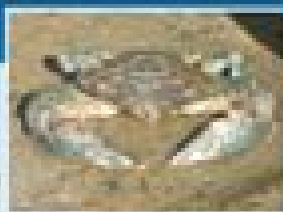
Limpets feed by scraping algae from rocks. These molluscs have rotating bands of colour with orange, yellow, brown and black dominating. They are eaten by crabs, spider-crabs and predatory gastropod snails.



Blue Swimmer Crab

Thalassidroma

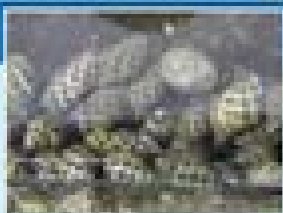
Common on rocky shores under stones and rocks. It grows to 70mm across. The flattened pair of legs identifies this crab as a swimmer crab. It has a smooth shell with mottled blue spots over the body and legs.



Mulberry Shells

Mytilus edulis

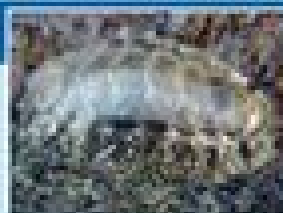
Mulberry Shells live in rock pools. They grow here in the top of the barnacle then suck out the animal. They are often found above high tide with *Zebrina peruviana* and limpets.



Gaimard's Chiton

Chiton gaimardi

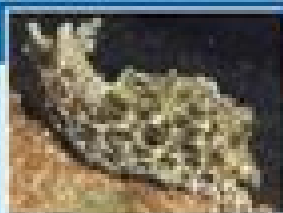
Chitons live in rock crevices in the intertidal zone and feed on algae. Gaimard's Chiton can be identified by the short spines which form black and white bands around the margin. Grows to approximately 40mm.



Black-ringed Sea Hare

Apollonia

The large flaps covering the body have black circles on the outside. This species can grow to 400mm and exudes a purple fluid when irritated. It feeds on red and green algae in rockpools and on rock platforms.

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Life Between the Tides Adam Nicolson,2025-08-22 Adam Nicolson explores the marine life inhabiting seashore rockpools with a scientist s curiosity and a poet s wonder in this beautifully illustrated book The sea is not made of water Creatures are its genes Look down as you crouch over the shallows and you will find a periwinkle or a prawn a claw displaying crab or a cluster of anemones ready to meet you No need for binoculars or special stalking skills go to the rocks and the living will say hello Inside each rock pool tucked into one of the infinite crevices of the tidal coastline lies a rippling silent unknowable universe Below the stillness of the surface course different currents of endless motion the ebb and flow of the tide the steady forward propulsion of the passage of time and the tiny lifetimes of the rock pool s creatures all of which coalesce into the grand narrative of evolution In Life Between the Tides Adam Nicolson investigates one of the most revelatory habitats on earth Under his microscope we see a prawn s head become a medieval helmet and a group of winkles transform into a Dickensian social scene with mollusks munching on Stilton and glancing at their pocket watches Or rather is a wrinkle more like Achilles an ancient hero throwing himself toward death for the sake of glory For Nicolson who writes with scientific rigor and a poet s sense of wonder The
