

NEW LIPID GUIDELINES

The European Society of Cardiology/European Atherosclerosis Society have released aggressive new lipid guidelines with **lower targets for low-density lipoprotein (LDL) reduction**. Key recommendations include the following:



Very-high-risk patients (10-year risk for cardiovascular [CV] death $> 10\%$): LDL cholesterol (LDL-C) reduction of $\geq 50\%$ from baseline and LDL-C goal of < 1.4 mmol/L (< 55 mg/dL) are recommended



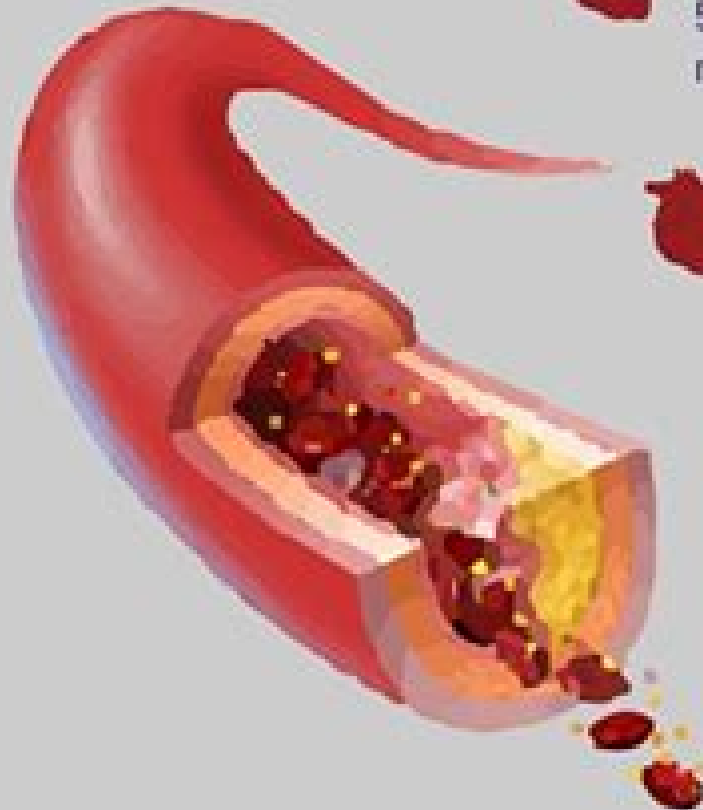
High-risk patients (10-year risk for CV death of 5% - 10%): LDL-C reduction of $\geq 50\%$ from baseline and an LDL-C goal of < 1.8 mmol/L (< 70 mg/dL) may be considered



Moderate-risk patients (10-year risk for CV death of 1% - 5%): LDL-C goal of < 2.6 mmol/L (< 100 mg/dL) should be considered



Low-risk patients (10-year risk for CV death $< 1\%$): LDL-C goal < 3 mmol/L (< 116 mg/dL) may be considered
