

HISTORY OF PHILOSOPHY

The history of philosophy spans thousands of years and encompasses a wide range of ideas, theories, and perspectives about existence, knowledge, values, reason, mind, and language. Here is an overview of the major periods and figures in the history of philosophy:

Ancient Philosophy

- **Pre-Socratic Period (7th–5th centuries BCE):**
 - Philosophers such as Thales, Pythagoras, and Heraclitus began to explore natural phenomena and the nature of existence.

Renaissance Philosophy (15th–17th centuries)

- Emphasized humanism, individualism, and the revival of classical learning.
- **Key Figures:** Erasmus, Thomas More, Desiderius Erasmus, Niccolò Machiavelli, Francis Bacon, René Descartes, Blaise Pascal, Pierre Bayle.
- **Key Themes:** The nature of the individual, the role of reason, and the relationship between science and religion.

Early Modern Philosophy (17th–18th centuries)

- Focused on the development of modern science and rationalism, and the rejection of medieval philosophy.
