European Security Policy and Strategic Culture Peter Schmidt, Benjamin Zyla, 2013-09-13 With the Lisbon Treaty in place and the European Union increasingly involved in international crisis management and stabilization operations in places near and far this volume revisits the trajectory of a European strategic culture Specifically it studies the usefulness of its application in a variety of circumstances including the EU's operations in Africa and the Balkans as well as joint operations with NATO and the United Nations The contributors find that strategic culture is a useful tool to explain and understand the EU's civilian and military operations not in the sense of a cause but as a European normative framework of preferences and constraints Accordingly classical notions of strategic culture in the field of international security must be adapted to highlight the specific character of Europe's strategic culture especially by taking the interaction with the United Nations and NATO into account Though at variance over the extent to which security and defence missions have demonstrated or promoted a shared strategic culture in Europe the authors reveal a growing sense that a cohesive strategic culture is critical in the EU's ambition of being a global actor Should Europe fail to nurture a shared strategic culture its actions will be based much more on flexibility than on cohesion This book was published as a special issue of Contemporary Security Policy *Europe: a time for strategy (Egmont Paper 27)*, 2009 The debate was concluded by the adoption of a Report on the Implementation of the European Security Strategy Providing Security in a Changing World by the December 2008 European Council 1 which decided to leave the text of the ESS itself untouched The Report does not replace the ESS but reinforces it and the ESS remains in force The question now is will actionable conclusions be drawn from the Report in order to effectively improve implementation of the ESS For even if one agrees with the decision not to revise the ESS itself problems of implementation there undoubtedly are If the process ends here most observers will rightfully be disappointed This Egmont Paper summarizes what we see as urgent priorities for the EU to address in order to fulfil its inevitable ambition of being a global strategic actor *The Routledge Handbook of European Security* Sven Biscop, Richard G.
