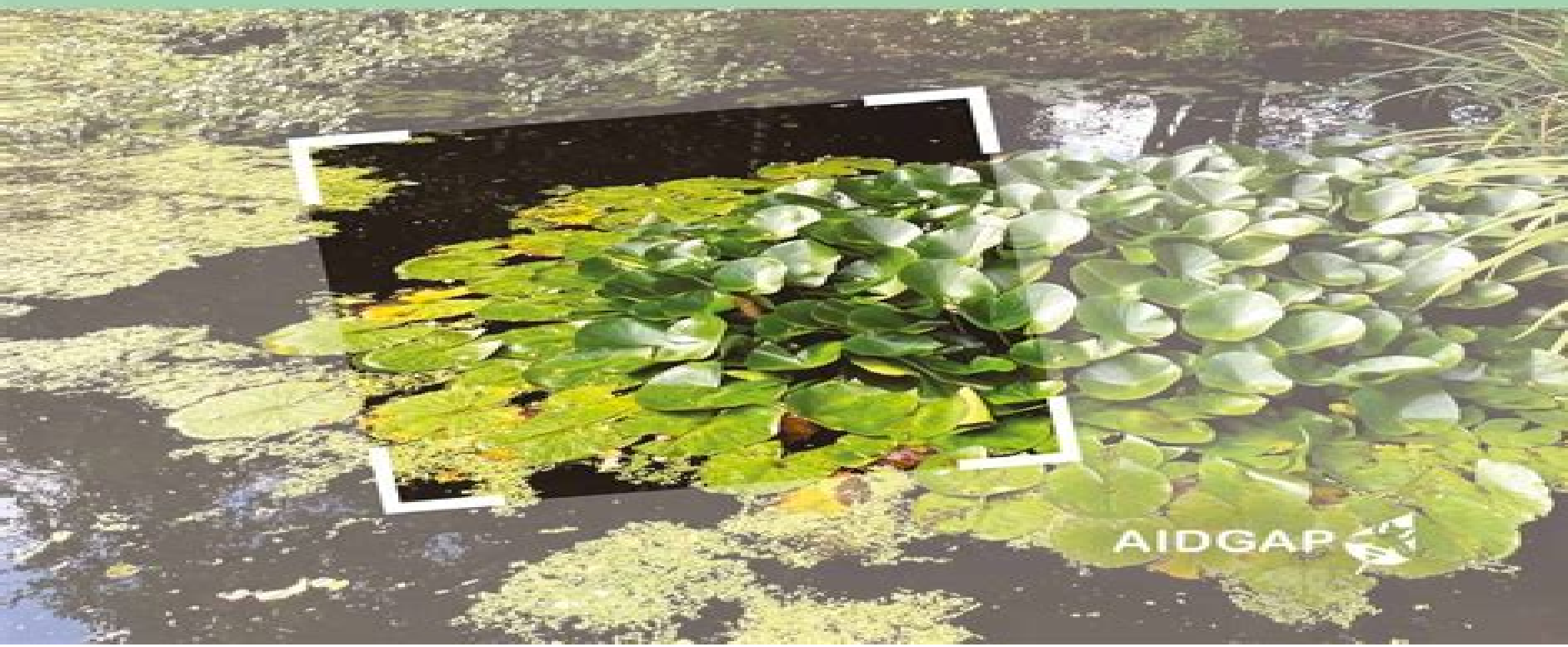

Flowers of Europe describes 2800 of the most common and interesting wild flowers to be found growing in Europe. For over 1900 of these species the book provides detailed descriptions, their distribution across the continent and their uses as poisons, dyes, foodstuffs or medicines. It also includes keys to the families and genera. The book's outstanding feature is its 192 pages of color plates containing roughly 1000 beautiful photographs of flowering plants in their natural settings. Line drawings are used to illustrate a further 280 species. Beginners in plant identification will appreciate the illustrated glossary of botanical terms. Equally useful are the lists of the names of well-known plants in French, German and Italian. First published in 1969 and familiarly known to plant enthusiasts as the black book, this classic text by Oleg Polunin, one of the foremost British botanists of his generation, has never been superseded. Ideal as a reference book for field trips, this reissued version will be welcomed by all students and researchers in botany, horticulture or plant sciences. Conservationists, naturalists and gardeners seeking a comprehensive guide to the flowering plants of Europe will also find it invaluable.

Field Guide to Invasive Plants and Animals in Britain Olaf Booy, Max Wade, Helen Roy, 2015-04-23
This field guide will enable the identification of a range of invasive plants and animals now found in Britain. The impact of invasive organisms is second only to habitat loss as a threat to biodiversity, and yet despite increasing ecological awareness, people remain largely unaware of these plants and animals and their potentially devastating impact. Although most biological introductions fail, many prove successful and these can prove disastrous for native fauna and flora. Though these species are of particular concern to conservationists, there has previously been no unified guide devoted to their recognition. This book will act both as an ID guide appealing to the amateur naturalist and as an important tool for ecologists and land managers attempting to tackle the problem posed by invasive species.

The European Garden Flora Flowering Plants James Cullen, Sabina G. Knees, H. Suzanne Cubey, J. M. H. Shaw, 2011-08-11
The European Garden Flora is the definitive manual for the accurate identification of cultivated ornamental flowering plants. Designed to meet the highest scientific standards, the vocabulary has nevertheless been kept as uncomplicated as possible so that the work is fully accessible to the informed gardener as well as to the professional botanist. This new edition has been thoroughly reorganised and revised, bringing it into line with modern taxonomic knowledge. Although European in name, the Flora covers plants cultivated in most areas of the United States and Canada as well as in non-tropical parts of Asia and Australasia. Volume 4 contains accounts of 82 families, mostly rather small but including the Primulaceae with *Primula* as its largest genus and Ericaceae with *Rhododendron* the largest genus in the Flora.
