

CHAPTER 6: Formulating The Hypothesis

Experimental Hypothesis- It is a statement that explains the effects of specified antecedent conditions on a measured behavior.

Example of Nonexperimental Hypotheses and Characteristics of Experimental Hypothesis

1. Synthetic Statements

-Are those that can be either true or false. Each experimental hypothesis must be a synthetic statement so that there can be some chance it is true and some chance it is false.

- Non Synthetic Statements should be avoided at all costs.

2 Categories of Non Synthetic Statements

a. Analytic statement - one that is always true

Example: "I am pregnant or I am not pregnant"

b. Contradictory statement - statements with elements that oppose each other because contradictory statements are always false.

Example: I have a brother and I don't have a brother.

2. Testable Statements

- An experimental hypothesis must also be testable-that means for manipulating antecedent conditions and measuring the resulting behavior must exist.

Example: If dogs display muscle twitches and vocalizations during sleep, then they must be dreaming.

3. Falsifiable Statements

- Statements of research hypotheses must be falsifiable by research findings. Hypotheses need to be worded so that failures to find the predicted effects must be considered evidence that the hypothesis is indeed false.

Example: If you read this book carefully enough, then you will be able to design a good experiment.

4. Parsimonious Statements

- Parsimony means that the simplest explanation is preferred.

Ex: If you look at an appealing photograph, then your pupils will dilate would be preferred over "If you look at an appealing photograph, then your pupils will dilate if it is a warm Saturday in June."

5. Fruitful Statements

- There is some indication that a hypothesis is fruitful when we can think of new studies that will become important if the hypothesis is supported.

Example: If a child, Albert, is repeatedly exposed to a loud, cry-inducing noise in the presence of a harmless furry animal, then Albert will begin to cry at the sight of the animal alone."

THE INDUCTIVE MODEL

• The inductive model of formulating a hypothesis, the process of reasoning from specific cases to more general principles, is often used in science and mathematics.

• You observed several specific instances of behavior and used these instances to form a general principle to explain the behavior. You may be able to come up with an interesting idea for testing it experimentally
