Writing an expository essay outline

Therefore no "meaning deformations" will occur, but the main point of the original article will be emphasized.
- The analysed event of situation should be review from the position of several sources thus making the expository essay stay focused on the context and very objective.
- 3. The conclusions in an expository essay should never be a surprise for the reader as they need to be easily traced throughout the essay. The analysis and the conclusions have to be always connected to each other. The reader should never have to guess what the author meant and never have a problem following the essay's reasoning.

A proper structure of an expository essay is a way to make it as effective as possible.

- 1. A narrow topic is presented
- 2. A thesis statement must express the main essence of the essay
- 3. The topic is developed through different opinions
- 4. The conclusion is made according to the summary of the presented above opinions

- The paragraphs supporting the thesis statement are supposed to have one main topicline. The rest of the sentences are to be directly related to this topic-line. This makes it easier for the reader to trace the logical movement of the essay.

 the main topic-line of the essay. The ending must be memorable.
