The letter should be personal and come from the heart, written with love and affection. The purpose of this letter is to show in writing what kind of parent you will be without listing off facts. Some parents tell the story of when they first met each other, or their [experiences with adoption](#). Others will share times of triumph or moments of sorrow, and how
