members of COM 8 and TG 3 4 for their work in developing this fib Bulletin which we hope will be useful for professionals working in the field of existing concrete structures especially those concerned with life cycle management and conservation activities As noted above this Bulletin is also intended to act as a background and supporting document to the next edition of the fib Model Code for Concrete Structures which is currently under development under the auspices of TG10 1 with the 2022 fib Awards for Outstanding Concrete Structures FIB - International Federation working title of fib Model Code 2020 for Structural Concrete, 2022-06-15 The fib has two major missions now One is to work toward the publication of the Model Code 2020 and the other is to respond to the global movement toward carbon neutrality While the former is steadily progressing toward completion the latter will require significant efforts for generations to come As we all know cement the primary material for concrete is a sector that accounts for 8 5% of the world's CO2 emissions And the structural concrete that fib handles consume 60% of that In other words we need to know the reality that our structural concrete is emitting 5% of the world's CO2 From now on fib members suppliers designers builders owner's engineers and academic researchers will be asked how to solve this difficult problem In general most of the CO2 emissions in the life cycle of structural concrete come from the production stage of materials and the use stage after construction i e A1 to A3 and B1 to B5 processes as defined in EN15978 Cement and steel sectors which are the main materials for structural concrete are expected to take various measures to achieve zero carbon in their respective sectors by 2050 Until then we must deal with the transition with our low carbon technologies Regarding the production stage the fib has recently launched TG4 8 Low carbon concrete And the latest low carbon technologies will be discussed there On the other hand in the use stage there is very little data on the relationship between durability and intervention and maintenance so far The data accumulation here is the work of the fib a group of various experts on structural concrete Through life management using highly durable structures and precise monitoring will enable to realize minimum maintenance in the use stage and to minimize CO2 emissions Furthermore it is also possible to contribute to the reduction of CO2 emissions in the further stage after the first cycle by responding to the circular economy that is deconstruction C reuse and recycle D However the technology in this field is still in its infancy and further research and development is expected in the future As described above structural concrete can be carbon neutral in all aspects of its conception and it can make a significant contribution when it is realized The fib will have to address these issues in the future Of course it will not be easy and it will take time However if we do not continue our efforts as the only international academic society on structural concrete in the world to achieve carbon neutrality the significance of our very existence may be questioned Long before Portland cement was invented Roman concrete made of volcanic ash and other materials was the ultimate low carbon material and is still in use 2 000 years later because of its non reinforced structure and lack of deterioration factors Reinforced concrete which made it possible to apply concrete to structures other than arches and domes is only 150 years old Prestressed concrete is even younger with only 80 years of history Now that we think about it we

realize that Roman concrete which is non reinforced low carbon concrete is one of the examples of problem solving that we are trying to achieve We have new materials such as coated reinforcement FRP and fiber reinforced concrete which can be used in any structural form To overcome this challenge with all our wisdom would be to live up to the feat the Romans accomplished 2 000 years ago Realizing highly durable and elegant structures with low carbon concrete is the key to meet the demands of the world in the future I hope you will enjoy reading this AOS brochure showing the Outstanding Concrete Structures Awards at the fib 2022 Congress in Oslo And I also hope you will find some clues for the challenges we are facing

Acceptance of post-tensioning systems for cryogenic applications FIB - International Federation for Structural Concrete, 2021-04-01 Since the Second World War the demand of energy has undergone an exponential growth that has led to a sharp annual increase in the use of natural gas in both cities and thermal power stations Nowadays the strategic relevance of natural gas as a main source of energy is evident with a contribution of more than 20% of the total world consumption This development in increasing demand of natural gas has led for a need of suitable storage and transportation infrastructure Various gases especially hydrocarbons are preferably stored in liquid form for transportation and storage since the phase transformation from gas to liquid comes with a significant reduction of the volume e g up to 600 times Gases can be liquefied by raising the pressure or by cooling to their boiling point which for most gases is below 0 C This is known as cryogenic storage The term cryogenic is derived from two Greek words namely kryos meaning icy cold and genes which can be translated as shape These fib recommendations are concerned about post tensioning systems used in cryogenic tanks and have been formulated on the basis of actual available knowledge with the aim to reflect the current state of the art Consequently these recommendations have included a classification of the different cryogenic tanks typologies used in the past and nowadays the associated different tendon types depending on their exposure to low temperature e.g. never only accidentally or during normal tank operation and the testing regime required for acceptance of the materials and the post tensioning system according to this document An international working group comprising more than 20 experts from administrative authorities universities laboratories owners structural designers suppliers of prestressing steels and post tensioning systems suppliers have actively contributed in order to develop these recommendations This text has been written to cover best construction practices around the world and to provide material specifications which are considered to be the most advanced available at the time of preparing this text For ease of use for Owner Designer and Post tensioning System Supplier the content has been arranged systematically according to the system components into chapters focusing on performance characteristics requirements and acceptance criteria Guidelines for Submerged Floating Tube Bridges FIB - International Federation for Structural Concrete, 2020-10-01 This bulletin is a guidelines document for Submerged Floating Tube Bridges that represents an innovation in Marine Concrete Structures This theme is considered important for Commission 1 since in the future several applications are forecast in marine environments Submerged Floating Tube Bridges

Popovich, Peter Zeile, Serviceability Limit State of Concrete Structures FIB - International Federation for Structural Concrete, 2019-09-01 Serviceability limit states are essential for appropriate function and durability of concrete structures The attention is paid especially to the stress limitation crack width analysis and deflection analysis The document provides supplementary information to the fib Model Code 2010 MC2010 where a limited space did not allow for a detailed description of individual procedures The principles used in MC2010 in chapter 7 6 are explained in detail within this document The stress analysis is focused on stresses in concrete and steel including the stress redistribution due to the long term load and cracking of reinforced concrete and prestressed concrete elements Crack width analysis explains the mechanism of cracking under mechanical loading and due to deformation restraint Cracks in prestressed concrete elements are also discussed Deflection analyses with different levels of accuracy are described including the shear effects Examples illustrate the practical application of rules defined in the MC2010 of individual serviceability limit states Simplified and more general methods are used An important part of the bulletin shows the development and extension of the serviceability limit states after publishing of the MC2010 and alternative approaches Special attention is paid to deflections of prestressed concrete beams shear effects on deflection slenderness limits and influence of the concrete cover The final part deals with an application of numerical simulations Precast-concrete buildings in seismic areas FIB - Féd. Int. du Béton, 2016 This document has a broad scope and is not focussed on design issues Precast construction under seismic conditions is treated as a whole The main principles of seismic design of different structural systems their behavior and their construction techniques are presented through rules construction steps and sequences procedures and details that should lead to precast structures built in seismic areas complying with the fundamental performance requirements of collapse prevention and life safety in major earthquakes and limited damage in more frequent earthquakes The content of this document is largely limited to conventional precast construction and although some information is provided on the well known PRESSS technology jointed ductile dry connections this latter solution is not treated in detail in this document The general overview contained in this document of alternative structural systems and connection solutions available to achieve desired performance levels intends to provide engineers architects clients and end users in general with a better appreciation of the wide range of applications that modern precast concrete technology can have in various types of construction from industrial to commercial as well as residential Lastly the emphasis on practical

aspects from conceptual design to connection detailing aims to help engineers to move away from the habit of blindly following prescriptive codes in their design but instead go back to basic principles in order to achieve a more robust understanding and thus control of the seismic behaviour of the structural system as a whole as well as of its components and individual connections Birth Certificate and Through-Life Management Documentation FIB - International Federation for Structural Concrete, 2020-06-01 While it is generally accepted by owners and users that vehicles such as airplanes or cars must be subjected to a pre defined maintenance plan during their lifetime this is less obvious in public opinion for engineering structures and buildings This may be related to the general feeling that moving objects should be more sensitive to aging and deterioration than structures anchored in ground This may also relate to the fact that detailed maintenance manuals which are considered obligatory by insurance companies are generally for aircraft boats and cars but not systematically for civil engineering structures except for iconic or major projects. The performance based approach to the durability design and assessment of concrete structures is also becoming increasingly popular in the construction sector In recent years numerous studies have been carried out worldwide in order to better assess the expected properties related to the durability of concrete This has led to the standardization of test protocols but also to a better understanding of the main parameters impacting the overall durability of concrete Documentation related to durability indicators will then become increasingly necessary for the accurate implementation of a performance based approach that enables the promotion of sustainable materials Durability models have a strong need for relevant in field data feedback in order to define accurate inputs for modelling both during the design process gathered from previous projects and during the follow up process to allow for re calibration of inputs and re assessment of durability expectations by the models if judged necessary A framework for data collection was therefore considered extremely importance by the fib Commission 8 Durability and is the objective of this fib Technical report Birth certificate and Through Life Management Documentation It is indeed very important to collect relevant data within a comprehensive and standardized format as now proposed by this fib Bulletin Thanks to its pre defined format compatible with the general fib framework Birth certificate and Through Life Management Documentation will definitively be useful to owners for the maintenance plan and intervention strategies of their assets This operational technical report will also be very useful for designers as it should encourage the collection of relevant information in databases to be used for future projects where a realistic assessment of expected properties is considered through largely similar concrete mix designs under given exposure conditions The Commission which deals with durability aspects hopes that this Bulletin will provide users a valuable tool and perspective on service life management issues Precast concrete bridge continuity over piers FIB - International Federation for Structural Concrete,2020-07-01 Concrete bridges are an important part of today s road infrastructure An important part of those concrete bridges is to a large extent prefabricated Precast concrete enables all the advantages of an industrialized process to be fully utilized Contemporary concrete mixtures are used to realize high

Int. du Béton, 2016 For a large part of the existing buildings and

infrastructure the design life has been reached or will be reached in the near future. These structures might need to be reassessed in order to investigate whether the safety requirements are met Current practice on the assessment of existing concrete structures however needs a thorough evaluation from a risk and reliability point of view as they are mostly verified using simplified procedures based on the partial factor method commonly applied in design of new structures Such assessments are often conservative and may lead to expensive upgrades Although the last decades reliability based assessment of existing concrete structures has gained wide attention in the research field a consistent reliability based assessment framework and a practically applicable codified approach which is compatible with the Eurocodes and accessible for common structural engineering problems in everyday practice is currently missing Such an approach however allows for a more uniform more objective and probably more widely applied assessment approach for existing concrete structures Hence in this bulletin two different partial factor formats are elaborated i e the Design Value Method DVM and the Adjusted Partial Factor Method APFM enabling the incorporation of specific reliability related aspects for existing structures The DVM proposes a fundamental basis for evaluating partial factors whereas the APFM provides adjustment factors to be applied on the partial factors for new structures in EN 1990 In this bulletin both methods are elaborated and evaluated and a basis is provided for decision making regarding the target safety level of existing structures Alternative Systems for Poultry Victoria Sandilands, Paul M. Hocking, 2012-01-01 Recent interest in how poultry are housed and managed in order to ensure profitability sustainability and good levels of animal welfare are challenging issues that commercial poultry keepers face particularly where legislation is bringing about legal requirements for housing This book compares and contrasts alternative housing with conventional and traditional systems for commercial poultry laying hens meat chickens turkeys waterfowl and gamebirds with regards to welfare disease health nutrition sustainability and genotype environment interaction It is suitable Precast segmental bridges fib Fédération internationale du for researchers and students in poultry science béton, 2017-08-01 The concept of precast segmental bridges is not new the first application documented was from the mid 1940s designed by Eugene Freyssinet and built over the river Marne near Luzancy in France between 1944 and 1946 Although innovative it also contained traditional wet concrete joints between the members The impressive breakthrough came slightly later with the introduction of match cast joints by Jean Muller first for a bridge near Buffalo USA in 1952 and later for a bridge across the River Seine at Choisy le Roi near Paris in 1962 This opened the way for a large number of new developments in terms of design production approaches and construction techniques and precast prestressed concrete segmental construction became rapidly one of the most efficient and successful bridge construction methods all over the world These developments are still evolving but the interaction between design production and construction is a critical factor for success the interaction creates opportunities to optimise the scheme but at the same time is crucial to ensure safety especially during construction when large weights are moved placed and secured frequently at substantial heights
