Jean Lescure s two volume General and Periodic Crises of Overproduction is a pioneering study of the causes and consequences of industrial crises in capitalist economies in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries The author who held doctorates in political economy and law is most remembered as a founder of the French historical school and a staunch advocate of empiricism in the economic sciences Lescure called his approach the complex historical method by which he sought to revise classical and quantitative economic theory through the historical analysis and statistical observation of cyclical phenomena Ever the controversialist Lescure wrote in an engaging style accessible to non specialists and economists alike and critiqued the leading monetary theorists of the period insisting that observation of the movements in production costs industrial orders and profits be given priority over circulation and credit in understanding the periodic crises of
