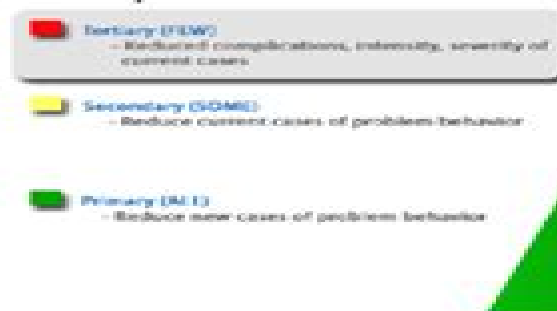

- **Families & Individuals in Societal Contexts**

- An understanding of families & their relationships to other institutions, such as the educational, gov't, religious, health care, and occupational institutions in society

- **FLES:**

- Life experiences redefine opportunities in social institutions
 - Families shape society just as society shapes families
 - Example: Coping w/ poverty as a child → challenges becoming successfully educated & employed as an adult
 - Lives and social institutions are moving targets
 - Change is constant; don't assume that relationships b/w systems & individuals will stay the same
 - Systems interact w/ each other, with families, & with individuals in important ways
 - Promote flexibility of social institutions that don't wrk w/ dynamic family life

- **Internal Dynamics of Families**

- An understanding of family strengths & weaknesses & how families relate to each other
 - May not always be obvious which & how internal family dynamics are @ play
 - Use predominant family theories to guide your wrk
 - Identify families strengths & challenges & help family members effective relate to each other

- **Human Growth & Development Across the Lifespan**

- An understanding of the developmental changes (both typical and atypical) of individuals in families across the lifespan based on knowledge of physical, emotional, cognitive, social, moral, and personality aspects
