

Intelligence study guide

Intelligence is the ability to learn from experience, solve problems, and use knowledge to adapt to new situations

General intelligence underlies all mental abilities and is therefore measured by every task on an intelligence test. This is according to Spearman and others

Gardner has identified that there are **8 relatively independent intelligences**, including the verbal and mathematical aptitudes assessed by standardized tests. The 8 intelligences are:

1. Naturalist
2. Linguistic
3. Logical-mathematical
4. Musical
5. Spatial
6. Bodily-kinesthetic
7. Intrapersonal
8. Interpersonal

Gardner also proposed the possibility of a 9th intelligence known as **existential intelligence** which is the ability to "ponder large questions about life, death, existence"

Savant syndrome a condition in which a person otherwise limited in mental ability has an exceptional specific skill, such as in computation or drawing

Sternberg proposes that there are **3 intelligences** rather than 8 or 9. The three intelligences include:

1. **Analytical (academic problem-solving) intelligence**
 - a. which is assessed by intelligence tests, which present well defined problems having a single right answer
2. **Creative intelligence**
 - a. Demonstrated in innovative smarts; the ability to adapt to new situations and generate novel ideas
3. **Practical intelligence** is required for everyday tasks that may be poorly defined and may have multiple solutions.

Emotional intelligence is the ability to perceive, understand, manage, and use emotions. It consists of 4 abilities:

1. **Perceiving emotions:** recognizing them in faces, music, and stories
2. **Understanding emotions:** predicting them and how they may change and blend
