Answer:

The survey describes Piaget's theory of the growth of intelligence and concludes the performance of these children at different ages in relation to Piaget's tasks.

Step 1: $N = 100$, $S = 15$, therefore $n = 100 - 15 = 85$

Explains the difference between assimilation and accommodation.

Assimilation is simply incorporating new information into our existing understanding of the information as being, well, not used to adjust our reference to fit the information. This process is known as *assimilation*.

Suppose that a 12-month-old toddler has learned to call the four-legged animal you or "doggy." What do you think would happen if the child saw a horse for the first time? Is the child likely to call the horse a "horse" or a "doggy" or a "doggy horse" or some other word? When you first point to the word "horse" and give a sentence explaining why you think the child would use that word or refer to the horse.

The child after seeing a horse for the first time will call it a "doggy" because of the strong reference with connecting four-legged animals with dogs.

Stages of Development

What are some characteristics of a child in the autonomous stage of development? What is object permanence?

In the autonomous stage of development, the child's intelligence is concerned with tactile sensations and motor skills. The child's thoughts are limited to the sensations being experienced and the objects being manipulated that moment.
