

Public Policy Paper **(Policy for Innovation and Transformation)**

Description

The Public Policy Paper (PPP) is the major output to be submitted by students in PSE4 - Policy Analysis and Design. It is a thoroughly researched and consulted policy for initiative that would address any of the critical issues currently being faced by their home agency and its community. Students may draw from their mentoring and coaching from the professor, and research extensively on potential benchmarks to formulate their PPP.

Students will present their Abstracts to the plenary, and the blind peer experts evaluate their Full Papers end of the course works. Each PPP will be given specific ratings based on relevance, innovativeness, inclusiveness, public-centric and implementable. The resulting overall rating will then be included in each student's final grade.

Objectives

As students go through the process of developing the PPP, they are expected to:

1. Identify and propose a specific and readily applicable policy innovation towards the government/private organizations improvement or transformation;
2. Research and design a systematic plan for the introduction and implementation of these innovations; and
3. Apply learning from the other BAPOS courses and demonstrate the core competencies of a graduate students.

Criteria

The PPP must display the following characteristics, which serve as the output's assessment criteria:

1. **Relevant.** The problem identified must be able to address a critical concern of the his/her sector taking into account its contribution to organization's interest and even to national development. The proposed initiative must contribute to the achievement of the institution's objectives.
2. **Innovative.** The plan must either introduce new, creative solutions to institutional problems, or strategic shifts that must be directed towards creating transformative change in the organization and its community.
3. **People-centric.** The plan must contribute in addressing the distinct needs, interests, and cultural upbringing of the people in the organization.
4. **Collaborative.** The development and implementation process of the plan must be inclusive, involving and impacting all major stakeholders of the agency/company.
5. **Implementable.** The plan must be directed towards implementation, and thus must incorporate concrete and comprehensive strategies addressing technical, political, administrative, and fiscal issues in implementation.

Requirements

By the end of the course, students are required to submit a written output detailing the concept and implementation arrangement of their PPP and present it to the class, and a discreet panel composed of representatives from relevant disciplines and sectors will evaluate their papers.
