Preventing Corporate Corruption Stefano Manacorda, Francesco Centonze, Gabrio Forti, 2014-04-28 This book presents the results of a two year international research project conducted for the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime UNDOC to investigate and provide solutions for reducing bribery and corruption in corporations and institutions It starts with an empirical case study on the effectiveness of a set of self regulation rules adopted by multinational companies in the energy sector Second it explores the context and factors leading to corruption internationally and the relationships between domestic criminal law and self regulation Third it examines guidelines for the adoption of compliance programs developed by international institutions to serve as models for the future The principle result of the book is a three pronged Anti Bribery Corruption Model so called ABC Model endorsed by the United Nations intended as a corruption prevention tool intended to be adopted by private corporations This work provides a common research based standard for anti bribery compliance programs with international applications This work will be of interest to researchers studying Criminology and Criminal Justice particularly in the areas of organized crime and corruption as well as related areas like Business Ethics and Comparative International Law

A Delicate Relationship Kenton Clymer, 2016-02-19 In 2012 Barack Obama became the first U S president ever to visit Myanmar formerly known as Burma This official state visit marked a new period in the long and sinuous diplomatic relationship between the United States and Burma Myanmar which Kenton Clymer examines in A Delicate Relationship From the challenges of decolonization and heightened nationalist activities that emerged in the wake of World War II to the Cold War concern with domino states to the rise of human rights policy in the 1980s and

beyond Clymer demonstrates how Burma Myanmar has fit into the broad patterns of U S foreign policy and yet has never been fully integrated into diplomatic efforts in the region of Southeast Asia When Burma a British colony since the nineteenth century achieved independence in 1948 the United States feared that the country might be the first Southeast Asian nation to fall to the communists and it embarked on a series of efforts to prevent this In 1962 General Ne Win who toppled the government in a coup d tat established an authoritarian socialist military junta that severely limited diplomatic contact and led to a period in which the primary American diplomatic concern became Burma s increasing opium production Ne Win s rule ended at least officially in 1988 when the Burmese people revolted against the oppressive military government Aung San Suu Kyi emerged as the charismatic leader of the opposition and was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1991 Amid these great changes in policy and outlook Burma Myanmar remained fiercely nonaligned and under Ne Win isolationist The limited diplomatic exchange that resulted meant that the state was often a frustrating puzzle to U S officials Clymer explores attitudes toward Burma later Myanmar from anxious anticommunism during the Cold War to interventions to stop drug trafficking to debates in Congress the White House and the Department of State over how to respond to the emergence of the opposition movement in the late 1980s The junta s brutality its refusal to relinquish power and its imprisonment of opposition leaders resulted in public and Congressional pressure to try to change the regime Indeed Aung San Suu Kyi s rise to prominence fueled the new foreign policy debate that was focused on human rights and in that climate Burma Myanmar held particularly large symbolic importance for U S policy makers Congressional and public opinion favored sanctions while U S presidents and their administrations were more cautious Clymer s account concludes with President Obama s visits in 2012 and 2014 and visits to the United States by Aung San Suu Kyi and President Thein Sein which marked the establishment of a new warmer relationship with a relatively open Myanmar

Migrants at Work Cathryn Costello, Mark Freedland, 2014-10-30

There is a highly significant and under considered intersection and interaction between migration law and labour law Labour lawyers have tended to regard migration law as generally speaking outside their purview and migration lawyers have somewhat similarly tended to neglect labour law The culmination of a collaborative project on Migrants at Work funded by the John Fell Fund the Society of Legal Scholars and the Research Centre at St John s College Oxford this volume brings together distinguished legal and migration scholars to examine the impact of migration law on labour rights and how the regulation of migration increasingly impacts upon employment and labour relations Examining and clarifying the interactions between migration migration law and labour law contributors to the volume identify the many ways that migration law as currently designed divides the objectives of labour law privileging concerns about the labour supply and demand over worker protective concerns In addition migration law creates particular forms of status which affect employment relations thereby dividing the subjects of labour law Chapters cover the labour laws of the UK Australia Ireland Israel Italy Germany Sweden and the US References are also made to discrete practices in Brazil France Greece New Zealand Mexico Poland and South

Africa These countries all host migrants and have developed systems of migration law reflecting very different trajectories. Some are traditional countries of immigration and settlement migration while others have traditionally been countries of emigration but now import many workers. There are nonetheless common features in their immigration law which have a profound impact on labour law for instance in their shared contemporary shift to using temporary labour migration programmes. Further chapters examine EU and international law on migration labour rights human rights and human trafficking and smuggling developing cross jurisdictional and multi level perspectives. Written by leading scholars of labour law migration law and migration studies this book provides a diverse and multidisciplinary approach to this field of legal interaction of interest to academics policymakers legal practitioners trade unions and migrants groups alike.

The Privatization of Israeli Security Shir Hever, 2017-11-20 Between 1994 2014 Israel's security service was transformed becoming one of the most extreme examples of privatised security in the world. Russia and the New World Disorder Bobo Lo, 2015-08-17 The Russian annexation of Crimea was one of the great strategic shocks of the past twenty five years. For many in the West Moscow's actions in early 2014 marked the end of illusions about cooperation and the return to geopolitical and ideological confrontation. Russia for so long a peripheral presence had become the central actor in a new global drama. In this groundbreaking book renowned scholar Bobo Lo analyzes the broader context of the crisis by examining the interplay between Russian foreign policy and an increasingly anarchic international environment. He argues that Moscow's approach to regional and global affairs reflects the tension between two very different worlds the perceptual and the actual. The Kremlin highlights the decline of the West a resurgent Russia and the emergence of a new multipolar order. But this idealized view is contradicted by a world disorder that challenges core assumptions about the dominance of great powers and the utility of military might. Its lesson is that only those states that embrace change will prosper in the twenty first century. A Russia able to redefine itself as a modern power would exert a critical influence in many areas of international politics. But a Russia that rests on an outdated sense of entitlement may end up instead as one of the principal casualties of global transformation.

Omar Nelson Bradley Steven L. Ossad, 2017-12-19 When Omar Nelson Bradley began his military career more than a century ago the army rode horses into combat and had less than 200 000 men. No one had heard of mustard gas. At the height of his career Bradley known as Brad and The GI's General led 1.23 million men as commander of 12 Army Group in the

Western Front to bring an end to World War II Omar Nelson Bradley was the youngest and last of nine men to earn five star rank and the only army officer so honored after World War II This new biography by Steven L Ossa gives an account of Bradley s formative years his decorated career and his postwar life Bradley s decisions shaped the five Northwest European Campaigns from the D Day landings to VE Day As the man who successfully led more Americans in battle than any other in our history his long term importance would seem assured Yet his name is not discussed often in the classrooms of either civilian or military academies either as a fount of tactical or operational lessons learned or a source of inspiration for leadership exercised at Corps Army Group Army Chief or Joint Chiefs of Staff levels The Bradley image was tailor made for the quintessential homespun American heroic ideal and was considered by many to be a simple humble country boy who rose to the pinnacle of power through honesty hard work loyalty and virtuous behavior Even though his classmates in both high school and at West Point made remarks about his looks and Bradley was always self conscious about smiling because of an accident involving his teeth he went on to command 12 Army Group the largest body of American fighting men under a single general Bradley s postwar career as administrator of the original GI Bill and first Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff during the Korean War ensures his legacy These latter contributions as much as Bradley s demonstrable World War II leadership shaped U S history and culture in decisive dramatic and previously unexamined ways Drawing on primary sources such as those at West Point Army War College and Imperial War Museum this book focuses on key decisions often through the eyes of eyewitness and diarist British liaison officer Major Thomas Bigland The challenges our nation faces sound familiar to his problems fighting ideologically driven enemies across the globe coordinating global strategy with allies and providing care and benefits for our veterans

War and Revolution in South China Edward J. M. Rhoads, 2021-09-10 In *War and Revolution in South China* Edward Rhoads recounts his childhood and early teenage years during the Sino Japanese War and the early postwar years Rhoads came from a biracial family His father was an American professor while his Chinese mother was a typist and stenographer In the late 1930s and the 1940s the Rhoads family lived through the turbulent years in southern China and Hong Kong The book follows Rhoads childhood in Guangzhou his family's evacuation to Hong Kong his father's internment and repatriation to the United States and his and his mother's flight to Free China He recalls his reunion with family members in northern Guangdong Province in 1943 their retreat to China's wartime capital of Chongqing where his father worked for the American government and how they returned to Guangzhou after the war The Rhoads family then witnessed the socioeconomic recovery in the city and the regime change in 1949 The book ends with their departure from China to the United States in 1951 a year and a half after the Communist revolution The book fills an important gap in the scholarship by examining the impact of the Sino Japanese War in southern China from the perspective of one family Rhoads reveals that the war in this region while often neglected by scholars was in fact no less turbulent than it was in northern and central China He combines autobiography with serious historical research to reconstruct the lives of his family consulting a large number of archival documents private correspondence and scholarly literature to produce a rare study that is both scholarly and accessible This book is a very timely reminder that one should look at the experience of China during the Second Sino Japanese War and the Second World War from a regional perspective in order to understand the diverse historical experience of the people from different geographical ethnic cultural and social backgrounds Chi man Kwong Hong Kong Baptist University A pleasure to read and of compelling interest Edward Rhoads book explores the more benign side of the foreign influence in modern China the introduction of modern educational institutions The intriguing lens through which we look is his biracial family their multiple flights across southern China as refugees escaping war and their eventual expulsion from China Stephen Davies The University of Hong Kong
