Grâce à son ample connaissance de l'œuvre, il raconte la douleur de l'exil et la nostalgie d'un pays devenu mythique, lieu de refuge et de consolation. Considéré comme un des meilleurs biographes de sa génération, traduit en de nombreuses langues, Alain Vircondelet a consacré plusieurs biographies de grandes figures de la littérature et de la spiritualité, dont Antoine de Saint-Exupéry, Marguerite Duras, Blaise Pascal et Saphirine de Senlis. Vous avez ce qu'il faut de justesse de ton de maîtrise dans la construction et de retenue dans l'émotion pour restituer dans sa vérité le Camus tel en tout cas que je l'ai connu.
