Françoise Sagan est morte le 24 septembre 2004. Elle laisse une dette fiscale de plus d'un million d'euros et une œuvre composée d'une trentaine de romans et d'une dizaine de pièces de théâtre sur le point d'être purement et simplement liquidée. Sagan est en passe de disparaître deux fois quand Denis Westhoff, son fils unique décide en 2006 d'accepter cette succession empoisonnée hors norme.
