| Activate prior knowledge<br>(2-3 min.)        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use vocabulary, oral introduction and title to make reasonable predictions</li><li>• Picture Walk/building background – quick; chunk sections, minimize and “let the author do the talking”<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▶ Identify tricky pictures or concepts that may interfere with comprehension during the reading of the text.</li><li>▶ Use selected pictures to predict outcomes</li></ul></li><li>• Use metacognition thinking stems</li><li>• Identify connections that students are able to make.</li><li>• Focus on higher level thinking skills/comprehension.</li></ul> |
