Mrs. Davenport informs you that she is allergic to iodine but no other allergies. She has no significant medical history other than her current symptoms, menopause (age 45), her last mammogram was 1 month ago, and she was hospitalized for pneumonia in December of 2016. She is not currently taking any medications.

Mrs. Davenport's symptoms began 2 days ago and have progressively gotten worse. She has had trouble sleeping and walking long distances without feeling out of breath. It all started after a weekend up in the mountains with her son and daughter-in-law.

On a scale of 1 – 10 her chest pain is around a 7.

In the last 5 years, Mrs. Davenport has no history of mental illness, has experienced no broken bones or strains and does not use orthotics. She is very busy with work and stays on the move designing show rooms for various companies. One of her clients even gave her a free mattress back in March after a successful show!
