that fell victim to the Nazi regimes In the last part I review books that discuss other genocides and crimes against humanity including the Stalinist mass purges the Cambodian massacres by the Pol Pot regime and the Rwandan genocide I want to emphasize that history can indeed repeat itself even if in different forms and contexts Just as the Jews of Europe were not the only targets of genocide Fascist regimes were not its only perpetrators
