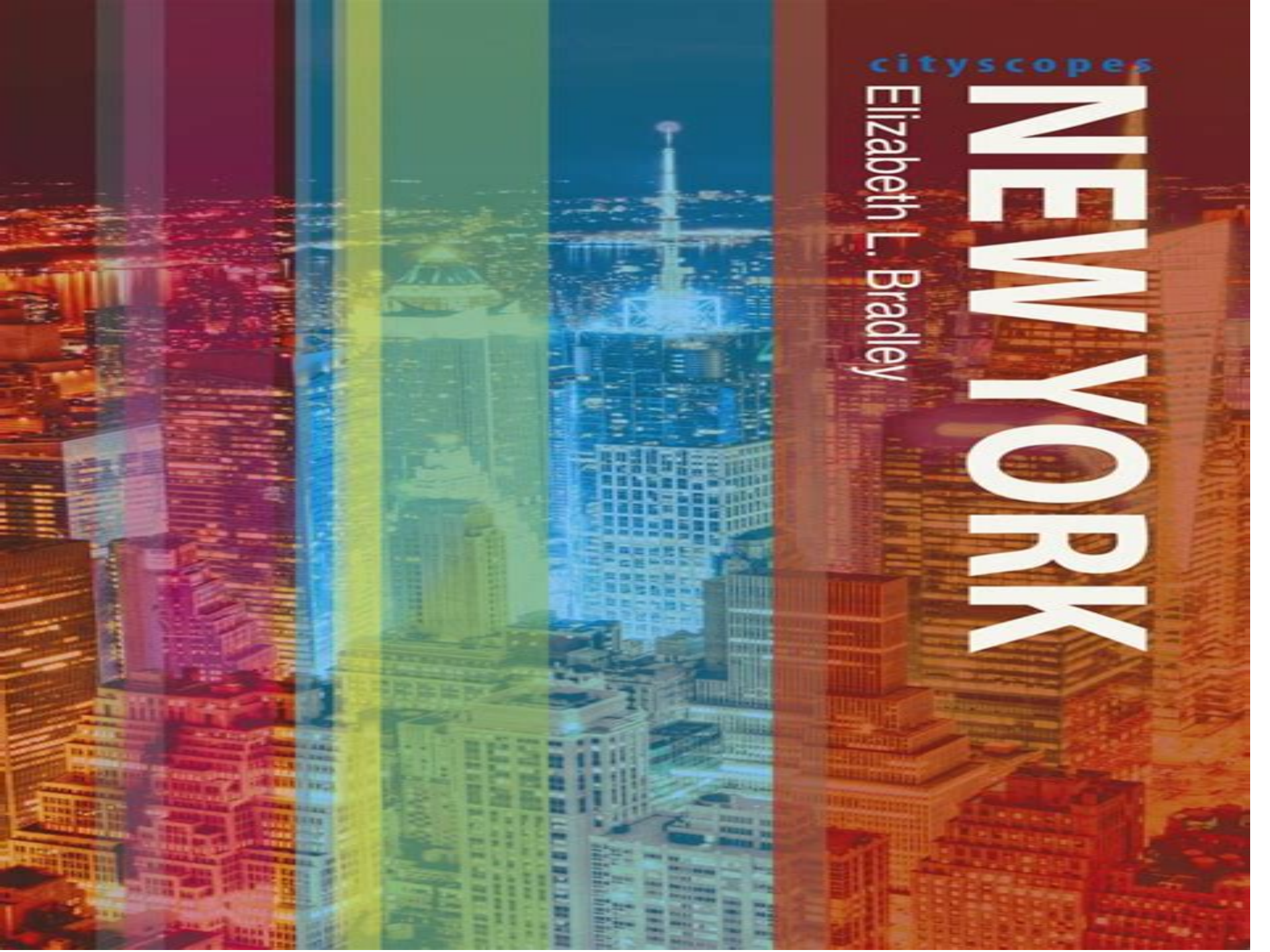

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New York Elizabeth L. Bradley, 2014-10-15 From the Big Apple to the City that Never Sleeps New York has many identities It is a melting pot of peoples and cultures a capital of finance and commerce and a mecca of fashion art and entertainment It is home to the United Nations Headquarters and Wall Street and it is the destination for millions of tourists each year But outside of the Empire State Building and the Statue of Liberty where does one even start In this concise and witty guide from a native New Yorker Elizabeth L Bradley mixes history with high and low culture to make sense of this city for visitors and armchair travelers alike Tracing the development of New York City from a Dutch trading post to the cultural capital of the world Bradley provides brief histories of each of the five boroughs and introduces the city's most important and colorful personalities In addition to a rich account of the city's past she offers a series of ruminations on themes germane to New York today describing its natural landmarks unnatural gin joints immigrant enclaves and even its many noises All along she includes thoughtful eclectic lists of where to eat drink and shop as well as what to see and do Exploring the features that make New York both inimitable and extraordinary this generously illustrated guide is a lively and engaging look at this ever shifting archipelago
