Training Requirements in OSHA Standards and Training Guidelines U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety Administration, 2014-03-18 Many standards promulgated by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration OSHA explicitly require the employer to train employees in the safety and health aspects of their jobs Other OSHA standards make it the employer's responsibility to limit certain job assignments to employees who are certified competent or qualified meaning that they have had special previous training in or out of the workplace The term designated personnel means selected or assigned by the employer or the employer's representative as being qualified to perform specific duties.
