



Bulk Collection of Signals Intelligence National Research Council, Division on Engineering and Physical Sciences, Computer Science and Telecommunications Board, Committee on Responding to Section 5(d) of Presidential Policy Directive 28: The Feasibility of Software to Provide Alternatives to Bulk Signals Intelligence Collection, 2015-03-24 The Bulk Collection of Signals Intelligence Technical Options study is a result of an activity called for in Presidential Policy Directive 28 PPD 28 issued by President Obama in January 2014 to evaluate U S signals intelligence practices The directive instructed the Office of the Director of National Intelligence ODNI to produce a report within one year assessing the feasibility of creating software that would allow the intelligence community more easily to conduct targeted information acquisition rather than bulk collection ODNI asked the National Research Council NRC the operating arm of the National Academy of Sciences and National Academy of Engineering to conduct a study which began in June 2014 to assist in preparing a response to the President Over the ensuing months a committee of experts appointed by the Research Council produced the report Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations National Research Council, Division on Engineering and Physical Sciences, Board on Army Science and Technology, Committee on Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations, 2014-12-15 The mission of the United States Army is to fight and win our nation s wars by providing prompt sustained land dominance across the full range of military operations and spectrum of conflict in support of combatant commanders Accomplishing this mission rests on the ability of the Army to equip and move its forces to the battle and sustain them while they are engaged Logistics provides the backbone for Army combat operations Without fuel ammunition rations and other supplies the Army would grind to a halt The U S military must be prepared to fight anywhere on the globe and in an era of coalition warfare to logistically support its allies While aircraft can move large amounts of supplies the vast majority must be carried on ocean going vessels and unloaded at ports that may be at a great distance from the battlefield As the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq have shown the costs of convoying vast quantities of supplies is tallied not only in economic terms but also in terms of lives lost in the movement of the materiel As the ability of potential enemies to interdict movement to the battlefield and interdict movements in the battlespace increases the challenge of logistics grows even larger No matter how the nature of battle develops logistics will remain a key factor Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations explores Army logistics in a global complex environment that includes the increasing use of antiaccess and area denial tactics and technologies by potential adversaries This report describes new technologies and systems that would reduce the demand for logistics and meet the demand at the point of need make maintenance more efficient improve inter and intratheater mobility and improve near real time in transit visibility Force Multiplying Technologies also explores options for the Army to operate with the other services and improve its support of Special Operations Forces This report provides a logistics centric research and development investment strategy and illustrative

intriguing is the fact that America's exuberant fascination with gold has continued long after Nixon's historic decree as in the profusion of late night television ads that appeal to goldbug speculators that proliferate even into the present One Nation Under Gold reveals as much about American economic history as it does about the sectional divisions that continue to cleave our nation ultimately becoming a unique history about economic irrationality and its influence on the American psyche
