### Polymerase Chain Reaction

#### Synopsis

In the Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) simulation, you will see through eight steps another reaction, similar to those that make plants, be multiplied exponentially, and you will find out the exact number of copies of the target DNA sequence in the test that the simulation will give you.

#### Design and

After sampling, you will go to the PCR simulation interface. The sample of DNA you collected by using a microchip is thermocycled, and this amplification from the initial sample is repeated 30 times. The final DNA sample contains approximately the 10<sup>7</sup>th generation.

#### How the structure of DNA results amplification of DNA

In the simulation, you will see the DNA amplification in the simulation, which illustrates the structure of DNA and the amplification of the sequence. It is a very important step in the experimental process, as well as an illustration of the PCR result.

#### Identify the number

In the PCR simulation, you will collect your sample and other samples. You will see the number of copies of the target DNA sequence in the test that the simulation will give you.
