Key Themes:

Love:

Conflict:

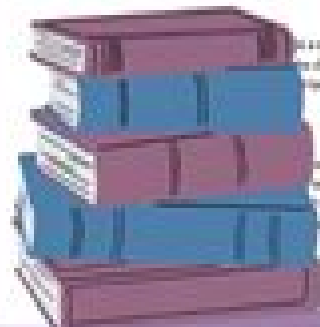
- Description: The feud between the Montagues and Capulets serves as a backdrop for the love between Romeo and Juliet, highlighting the conflict between the two families.

- Examples: Romeo and Juliet's rapid decision to marry, Romeo's impulsive decision to kill Tybalt, Juliet's decision to take her own life.

Individuality vs. Society:

- Description: The play explores the tension between the desires and expectations and constraints of society. The lovers challenge social norms.
- Examples: Romeo and Juliet's secret marriage, Juliet's defiance of her father's arranged marriage.
