- Monitoring: fauna and aquatic habitats
- Establishment and monitoring of alternative production networks of handicrafts of crocodile fish skins
- Development of cartographic information
- Strengthening of responsible tourism
- Studies on the possible impact of hydroelectrical dam constructions
