 This problem is essentially Membacher, Chapter 18, Problem 4 for Sakurai, Chapter 5, Problem IJ. Consider a one-dimensional harmonic oscillator perturbed by a constant force.

$$H = \frac{p^2}{2m} + \frac{1}{2}m\omega^2x^2 - Fx$$

a) Show that the first order perturbation in the energy levels vanishes

Pringeriors, 5-1-2:

Since we will need to find the second order perturbation in part b), let us consider the general matrix element

Williamson 2000s.

$$V_{min} := -F(me^{(m)})x(m^{(m)})$$

The operator x is given in terms of sreation and annihilation operators by $x = \sqrt{h/(2m\omega)(a^2 + a)}$. Thus

$$V_{mn} = -F \sqrt{\frac{\hbar}{2m\omega}} [m^{(n)}](\alpha^4 + a)(n^{(n)})$$

= $-F \sqrt{\frac{\hbar}{2m\omega}} [\sqrt{n+1}\delta_{m,n+1} + \sqrt{n}\delta_{p,n-1}]$

This indicates that the x operator changes the oscillator number by ± 1 . In particular, $V_{nn} = 0$, which demonstrates that the first order energy perturbation vanishes.

6) Now calculate the eigenenergies E_n up to second order in the perturbation. Using the matrix element calculated above, are find:
