This Victorian visual turn prefigured the present day impact of the Internet on how images are produced and shared both driving and reflecting the visual culture of its time. From this starting point *Drawing on the Victorians* sets out to explore the relationship between Victorian graphic texts and today's steampunk manga and other neo-Victorian genres that emulate and reinterpret their predecessors. Neo-Victorianism is a flourishing worldwide phenomenon but one whose relationship with the texts from which it takes its inspiration remains underexplored. Philip Payton Kevin McGruder, 2021-07-06 At the turn of the early twentieth century Harlem the iconic Black neighborhood was predominantly white The Black real estate entrepreneur Philip Payton played a central role in Harlem's transformation He founded the Afro American Realty Company in 1903 vowing to vanquish housing discrimination Yet this ambitious mission faltered as Payton faced the constraints of white capitalist power structures In this biography Kevin McGruder explores Payton's career and its implications for the history of residential segregation Payton stood up for the right of Black people to live in Harlem in the face of vocal white resistance Through skillful use of print media he branded Harlem as a Black community and attracted interest from those interested in racial uplift Yet while Payton opened Harlem streets his business model depended on continued racial segregation Like white real estate investors he benefited from the lack of housing options available to desperate Black tenants by charging higher rents Payton developed a specialty in renting all Black buildings rather than the integrated buildings he had once envisioned and his personal successes ultimately entrenched Manhattan's racial boundaries McGruder highlights what Payton's story shows about the limits of seeking advancement through enterprise in a capitalist system deeply implicated in racial inequality At a time when understanding the roots of residential segregation has become increasingly urgent this biography sheds new light on the man and the forces that shaped Harlem

Ballot Blocked Jesse H. Rhodes, 2017-09-12 Voting rights are a perennial topic in American politics Recent elections and the Supreme Court's decision in *Shelby County v Holder* which struck down key enforcement provisions in the Voting Rights Act VRA have only placed further emphasis on the debate over voter disenfranchisement Over the past five decades both Democrats and Republicans in Congress have consistently voted to expand the protections offered to vulnerable voters by the Voting Rights Act And yet the administration of the VRA has become more fragmented and judicial interpretation of its terms has become much less generous Why have Republicans consistently adopted administrative and judicial decisions that undermine legislation they repeatedly endorse *Ballot Blocked* shows how the divergent trajectories of legislation administration and judicial interpretation in voting rights policymaking derive largely from efforts by conservative politicians to narrow the scope of federal enforcement while at the same time preserving their public reputations as supporters of racial equality and minority voting rights Jesse H Rhodes argues that conservatives adopt a paradoxical strategy in which they acquiesce to

expansive voting rights protections in Congress where decisions are visible and easily traceable while simultaneously narrowing the scope of federal enforcement via administrative and judicial maneuvers which are less visible and harder to trace Over time the repeated execution of this strategy has enabled a conservative Supreme Court to exercise preponderant influence over the scope of federal enforcement

MacKinnon, 2020-02-24 Closing Sysco presents a history of deindustrialization and working class resistance in the Cape Breton steel industry between 1945 and 2001 The Sydney Steel Works is at the heart of this story having existed in tandem with Cape Breton s larger coal operations since the early twentieth century The book explores the multifaceted nature of deindustrialization the internal politics of the steelworkers union the successful efforts to nationalize the mill in 1967 the years in transition under public ownership and the confrontations over health safety and environmental degradation in the 1990s and 2000s Closing Sysco moves beyond the moment of closure to trace the cultural historical and political ramifications of deindustrialization that continue to play out in post industrial Cape Breton Island A significant intervention into the international literature on deindustrialization this study pushes scholarship beyond the bounds of political economy and cultural change to begin tackling issues of bodily health environment and historical memory in post industrial places The experiences of the men and women who were displaced by the decline and closure of Sydney Steel are central to this book Featuring interviews with former steelworkers office employees managers politicians and community activists these one on one conversations reveal both the human cost of industrial closure and the lingering after effects of deindustrialization

Heading South to Teach Kim Tolley,2015-08-31 Susan Nye Hutchison 1790 1867 was one of many teachers to venture south across the Mason Dixon Line in the Second Great Awakening From 1815 to 1841 she kept journals about her career family life and encounters with slavery Drawing on these journals and hundreds of other documents Kim Tolley uses Hutchison s life to explore the significance of education in transforming American society in the early national period Tolley examines the roles of ambitious educated women like Hutchison who became teachers for economic spiritual and professional reasons During this era working women faced significant struggles when balancing career ambitions with social conventions about female domesticity Hutchison s eventual position as head of a respected southern academy was as close to equity as any woman could achieve in any field By recounting Hutchison s experiences from praying with slaves and free blacks in the streets of Raleigh and establishing an independent school in Georgia to defying North Carolina law by teaching slaves to read Tolley offers a rich microhistory of an antebellum teacher Hutchison s story reveals broad social and cultural shifts and opens an important window onto the world of women s work in southern education

New Statesman and Nation ,1948 **In Defence of Britain's Middle Eastern Empire** Timothy Paris,2015-10-30 T E Lawrence of Arabia described his war time chief as the perfect leader a man who worked by influence rather than by loud direction He was like

water or permeating oil creeping silently and insistently through everything It was not possible to say where Clayton was and was not and how much really belonged to him This is the first biography of General Sir Gilbert Clayton 1875 1929 Britain's pre eminent man on the spot during the formative years of the modern Middle East Serving as a soldier administrator and diplomat in ten different Middle Eastern countries during a 33 year Middle Eastern career Clayton is best known as the Director of British Intelligence in Cairo during the Great War 1914 16 and as the instigator and sponsor of the Arab Revolt against the Turks Dedicated to the preservation of Britain's Middle Eastern empire Clayton came to realize that in the transformed post war world Britain could ill afford to control all aspects of the emerging nation states in the region In his work as adviser to the Egyptian government 1919 22 he advocated internal autonomy for the Egyptians while asserting Britain's vital imperial interests in the country As chief administrator in Palestine 1923 5 he sought to reconcile the Arabs to Britain's national home policy for the Jews and at the same time to solidify Britain's position as Mandatory power In Arabia Clayton negotiated the first post war treaties with the emerging power of Ibn Saud 1925 1927 but curtailed his designs on the British Mandates in Iraq and Transjordan And in Iraq where Clayton served as High Commissioner 1929 he backed Iraq's independence within the framework of the British Empire

Imagining a Nation Ruramisai Charumbira, 2015-09-29 In *Imagining a Nation* Ruramisai Charumbira analyzes competing narratives of the founding of Rhodesia Zimbabwe constructed by political and cultural nationalists both black and white since occupation in 1890 The book uses a wide array of sources including archives oral histories and a national monument to explore the birth of the racialized national memories and parallel identities that were in vigorous contention as memory sought to present itself as history In contrast with current global politics plagued by divisions of outsider and insider patriot and traitor Charumbira invites the reader into the liminal spaces of the region's history and questions the centrality of the nation state in understanding African or postcolonial history today Using an interdisciplinary methodology Charumbira offers a series of case studies bringing in characters from far flung places to show that history and memory in and of one small place can have a far reaching impact in the wider world The questions raised by these stories go beyond the history of colonized or colonizer in one former colony to illuminate contemporary vexations about what it means to be a citizen patriot or member of a nation in an ever globalizing world Rather than a history of how the rulers of Rhodesia or Zimbabwe marshaled state power to force citizens to accept a single definition of national memory and identity *Imagining a Nation* shows how ordinary people invested in the soft power of individual social and collective memories to create and perpetuate exclusionary national myths *Reconsiderations in Southern African History*

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
