Accommodations/ Modifications	1:1 will be typical for most students throughout each class period. Occasionally (but not often,) there may be a 2:1 situation, small group, whole group, or independent student learning. All of my students work with a continuous token system throughout the day. They identify what they are working for (snack, walk, break, music, etc.) and earn 1 token per activity. Once they have gotten 3 tokens, they earn the reward they were working for. Then, the cycle begins again as they begin working again. Some students may receive more than 1 token for an activity depending on how much work was required for that individual student. Multiple intelligences and sensory needs will be addressed. Some students utilize communication devices.
