can improve the protection of children in armed conflict situations in accordance with international law and policy It is intended for use particularly by those involved in training of national armed forces including officers themselves and members of governments non governmental organisations NGOs and inter governmental organisations It is hoped that it will also be of interest to lawyers academics and others concerned with child rights and related law and policy It contains examples of actual training materials that can be modified for use in different countries and contexts
