It comes with a free Mobile App called MINI that allows beginner users to operate the MINI through its pre-programmed motions. But the potential use for this kit in educational robotics is largely untapped due to lack of information and practicum sources for users to develop their own projects and to help them learn more about humanoid robotics programming.
