KQ1: How successful was the government in providing social security for the soviet people between 1917 and 1985? – Lenin, Stalin, Khrushchev and Brezhnev

Factors	Successful	Not Successful
Full Employment	- 1928-1937 workers number rose from 11.6mill to 27mill. With skilled workers receiving benefits. - Alexi Stakhanov mined 15x the average – model workers like him were rewarded with better flats and better rations to improve productivity - Women employed in greater numbers during WW2 → Workplace benefits included cheap food in the canteen, access to meat, free work clothes -VE: only given 2weeks paid leave (Trade Union) - incomes of collective farmers increased in 1966 due to KHH's investment in agriculture - Developed socialism – Constitution 1977 meant all citizen had full employment and wages grew by 50% (limited gap between best and worst pay) - Job security – workers kept their jobs as it was difficult to be sacked. Minimum wage was introduced along with the working week. + number of days paid holiday increased.	- Working conditions were poor, and there were very little health and safety in check. - Average Soviet worker only produced half of what an average British worker did (night shifts were introduced to meet this) - Workers constantly changed occupations – by 1937, 30% of urban workers had changed jobs in each quarter of the year. - 1931 saw harsh punishments introduced and also wage difference between skilled and unskilled - 1939 Absenteeism from work became a criminal offence - Women were employed in greater numbers. - By 1970s wages of rural workers were only 10% less than urban workers - Lots of people had no job satisfaction - Labour turnover remained high. - Target from 9th 5yr plan for production of food not always met
Housing	- 1930s Block apartments built to relieve the high population growth. - Workers who showed impressive commitment to fulfilling the 5yr plan received better apartments with running water, electricity and central heating - Rent was very low - Khrushchev's extensive housing programme = more housing was provided. - Housing provided by the state increased from 178 mill squares metres to 394 mill squares metres (so more housing was available) -	- The growth of towns and industrial centres (Magnitogorsk) under the 5yr plans put a great strain on housing. – these cities lacked proper facilities and workers had to sleep in tents, huts and factories - Houses available all looked the same + had elements to promote communism - In 1936 only 6% of rented housing units consisted of more than one room - At least 5% of people lived in a kitchen or corridor and in dormitories - The lack of housing put pressure on family's lives. - Housing provision was worse in the countryside as peasants were expected to provide their own housing - After WW2 cities lost majorities of the housing building – Stalingrad lost 90% of its housing and Leningrad lost 1/3 - Houses given were not often completed to a high standard – finishing touches were left to the tenants
