flourished which used exactly the same method to produce both an interpretation of the Reformed sacramental rites and an anti commentary on Catholic liturgy The book demonstrates an important continuity across the Reformation divide arguing that the Scottish Reformation is best seen as both Catholic and Protestant with the reformers on both sides having more in common than they or subsequent historians have allowed
