Rafael Moneo Rafael Moneo, 2010-09-07 Rafael Moneo is a courageous architect one who for decades has defined his own style of architecture With a sensitivity to materials and context unmatched by any living architect Moneo has created a series of important works including the Audrey Jones Beck Building at the Museum of Fine Arts in Houston Our Lady of the Angels Cathedral in Los Angeles and perhaps most notably the extension to the Prado Museum in Madrid A teacher and critic Moneo now turns his analytical eye to his own work Twenty one carefully selected projects are presented in detail from the initial idea and through construction to the completed work and illustrated by a spectacular suite of new color images by architectural photographer Michael Moran These are combined with Moneo's own drawings as well as informal documentary material from the design of each of the projects

Thinking Through Twentieth-Century Architecture Nicholas Ray, 2023-02-08 Shortlisted for the Architectural Book Awards 2024 *Thinking Through Twentieth Century Architecture* connects the practice of architecture with its recent history and its theoretical origins those philosophical ideas that lay behind modernism and its aftermath By analyzing in straightforward and jargon free language the genesis of modernism and the complex reactions to it the book clarifies a continuing debate It has been specifically written to connect issues of theory history and contemporary practice and to allow students to make these connections easily This is a history of twentieth century architecture written with close critical attention to the theories that lie behind the works described Importantly unlike other historical accounts it does not take

sides and urge the reader to identify with one strand of thinking or style of architecture at the expense of others but it presents a dispassionate view with persuasive arguments on behalf of different positions. It pursues the history of European and American architecture chronologically but the history is interwoven with the philosophical ideas that informed both writers and architects and are essential for its understanding. The book is relevant to current issues of contemporary practice and education showing that philosophical issues are fundamental and those relating to design decisions never go away. It includes 200 illustrations and will appeal to all those interested in twentieth century architecture and to architectural students.

Translucent Building Skins Scott Murray, 2013-05-07 Exploring the design of innovative building enclosure systems or skins in contemporary architecture and their precedents in earlier twentieth century modern architecture, this book examines the tectonics, the history and the influence of translucency as a defining characteristic in architecture. Highly illustrated throughout with drawings and full colour photographs, the book shows that translucency has been and continues to be a fertile ground for architectural experimentation. Each chapter presents a comparative analysis of two primary buildings, a recent project paired with a historical precedent, highlighting how architects in different eras have realized the distinctive effects of translucency.
