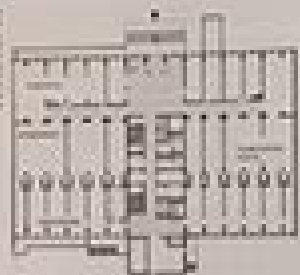
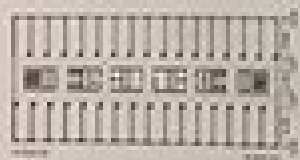


1. Section through a single unit

The structure is usually of the type shown in the diagram.

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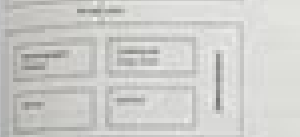
