

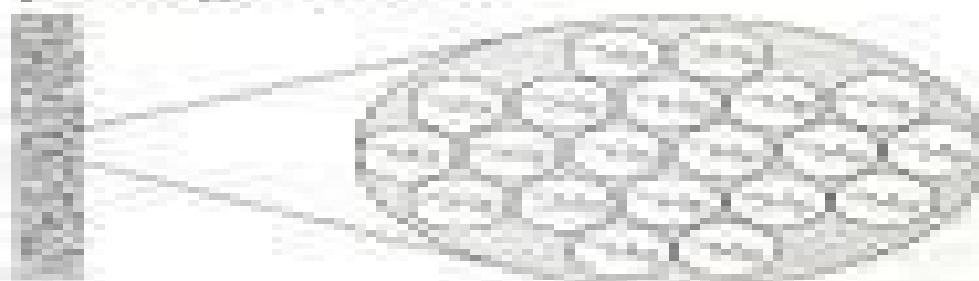
Average Atomic Mass

How can the masses of the particles tell us something?

Why?

Many different isotopes exist. They are naturally occurring species. As you learned previously, the mass of these isotopes varies due to the number of protons (number of particles) existing inside the nucleus. However, not all isotopes have different mass numbers (total number of protons and neutrons existing inside their nucleus). For example, carbon has two isotopes (12 and 13). The particles within the nuclei present in an atom of carbon have very different mass numbers (total number of protons and neutrons) but have the same mass.

They are the same as the ones shown in Model 1.
2. What are the mass numbers of the particles composing the strip of magnesium shown in Model 1?

No, since the mass numbers of the atoms are different, their masses cannot all be the same.
4. How the masses of the particles composing the strip in Model 1 show a slight fluctuation in the mass numbers of the atoms present and the masses of some of the atoms present.
