Nussbaum, 1992-04-02 This volume brings together Nussbaum's published papers on the relationship between literature and philosophy especially moral philosophy The papers many of them previously inaccessible to non specialist readers deal with such fundamental issues as the relationship between style and content in the exploration of ethical issues the nature of ethical attention and ethical knowledge and their relationship to written forms and styles and the role of the emotions in deliberation and self knowledge Nussbaum investigates and defends

National Labor Relations Board, 1977 *Chains of Love and Beauty* Carolyn Dever, 2022-04-19 Michael Field was the pseudonym of two women writing as a male author Katharine Bradley and Edith Cooper who were aunt and niece and a devoted couple for three decades that spanned the late nineteenth and the early twentieth centuries While much has been written about the Fields many volumes of poetry and plays and about their strange and complicated life this book is the first to focus on their diary which they kept for twenty five years and viewed as an unpublished manuscript called Works and Days In this book Dever argues that Works and Days represents one of the great experimental prose narratives of the transitional period between Victorian and modernist literature Through the co written diary which fills twenty nine volumes and about 9 500 pages the women envisioned a life beyond the tight horizons of one home and one family and portrayed new forms of women's intimacy at the dawn of the twentieth century Dever focuses on five pivotal years in the life of Bradley and Cooper as reflected in the diary the death of Cooper's mother a year of personal

leading moral philosophers of the past as participants in a rational discussion that is still being carried on and tries to help the reader to participate in this discussion

Religion and Morality Daniel Statman, Avi Sagi, 2022-06-08 Religion and Morality seeks to answer two fundamental questions regarding the relation between religion and morality The first is the puzzle posed by Socrates the so called Euthyphro dilemma which asks is morality valuable by virtue of its intrinsic importance and worth or is morality valuable because and only because God approves it and commands us to follow its dictates The second question is raised by Kierkegaard in Fear and Trembling He asks Is a conflict between religion and morality possible Does God ever demand that we neglect our moral commitments The discussion on these questions is divided into three parts In the first two parts we discuss the idea that morality depends on religion The authors distinguish two types of dependence strong dependence according to which the very existence or validity of moral obligations depends on God's command and weak dependence according to which though morality itself is independent of God God or belief in God is necessary to enable human beings to know their moral duties and to carry them out The authors reject the strong dependence thesis as well as most versions of the weak dependence The third part of the book discusses different versions of the view that religion might conflict with morality The authors reject this view and show that very few religious thinkers would follow it all the way through to its ultimate consequences The book has implications for the philosophy of religion in its emphasis on the centrality of the moral element in religion and for moral philosophy in its highlighting among other things of the nature of moral judgments

Historical View of the Literature of the South of Europe Jean-Charles-Léonard Simonde Sismondi, 1871 *The Radical Demand in Løgstrup's Ethics* Robert Stern, 2019-01-03 How much does ethics demand of us On what authority does it demand it How does what ethics demand relate to other requirements such as those of prudence law and social convention Does ethics really demand anything at all Questions of this sort lie at the heart of the work of the Danish philosopher and theologian K E Løgstrup 1905 1981 and in particular his key text *The Ethical Demand* 1956 In *The Radical Demand in Løgstrup's Ethics* Robert Stern offers a full account of that text and situates Løgstrup's distinctive position in relation to Kant Kierkegaard Levinas Darwall and Luther For Løgstrup the ethical situation is primarily one in which the fate of the other person is placed in your hands where it is then your responsibility to do what is best for them The demand therefore does not come from the other person as such as what they ask you to do may be different from what you should do It is also not laid down by social rules nor by God or by any formal principle of practical reason such as Kant's principle of universalizability Rather it comes from what is required to care for the other and the directive power of their needs in the situation Løgstrup therefore rejects accounts of ethical obligation based on the commands of God or on abstract principles governing practical reason or on social norms instead he develops a different picture at the basis of which is our interdependence which he argues gives his ethics a grounding in the nature of life itself

Virtue, Vice, and Value Thomas Hurka, 2003 Hurka's book puts forth a comprehensive theoretical account of moral virtue and vice More specifically it gives an account of the intrinsic goodness of virtue and intrinsic evil of vice that can fit into a consequentialist moral theory

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
