Bernard Shaw's Book Reviews Brian Tyson,2008-01-31 These hitherto uncollected book reviews of Shaw his first journalistic efforts reveal much not only about the writer but also the culture of the time in which he lived Between 1885 and 1888 Bernard Shaw published 111 book reviews in the Pall Mall Gazette In spite of their importance as the first regular journalism Shaw wrote and the fact that the books fiction nonfiction plays and poetry he read during these years must have formed the nucleus of his permanent library the reviews have never before been analyzed in connection with Shaw s work Brian Tyson has assembled the book reviews complete with the books titles authors and a brief biography of each author including any comments Shaw made about the review and has placed them in historical context elucidating any interesting difficult or obscure references Tyson s critical introduction places the reviews in the context of Shaw s work and Victorian society The reviews are often characterized by the wit and brilliance that we associate with the later Shaw shedding light on his development as a writer at his most formative stage Regardless of the merits of the material Shaw was reviewing it is amusing and enlightening to follow him down to the wandering tributaries of Late Victorian fiction and poetry which reveal as much about Shaw as they do about the preoccupations and prejudices of the average reader of the day Remembrance Ray Bradbury,2024-11-19 Ray Bradbury the iconic author of Fahrenheit 451 The Martian Chronicles and Something Wicked This Way Comes believed that a collection of his letters could someday illuminate the story of his life in new ways That story emerges across time and memory in the pages of Remembrance Ray Bradbury was one of the best known writers and creative dreamers of our time The many honors he received which included an Emmy and Academy Award nomination for adaptations of his work culminated in the 2000 National Book Foundation s Medal for Distinguished Contribution to American Letters a 2004 National Medal of Arts and a 2007 Pulitzer Prize Special Citation For many years NASA and the Disney Studio felt the impact of Ray Bradbury s creativity and his fiction has found its way into hundreds of anthologies textbooks and the National Endowment for the Arts Big Read program His enduring legacy as a storyteller novelist and space age visionary radiated out into popular adaptations for stage film and television and now the fascinating narratives and insights of his personal and professional correspondence are revealed for the first time Remembrance offers the first sustained look at his life in letters from his late teens to his ninth decade Bradbury s correspondence was far reaching he interacted with a rich cross section of 20th century cultural figures writers film directors editors and others who simply wanted insights or encouragement from a writer who had enriched their lives through his stories and novels Bradbury scholar and biographer Jonathan R Eller organized this volume into categories of correspondents showing Bradbury s progression through life as he knew it and not necessarily as the public perceived him Letters to and from mentors and other
